Main thoughts to hold: "Stretching More in 2004" IS.54:2-3 'MULTIPLICATION ANOINTING'

"Enlarge the place of your tent, stretch your tent curtains wide, do not hold back; lengthen your cords, strengthen your stakes, for you will spread out to the right and to the left; your descendants will dispossess nations and settle in their desolate cities." Isaiah 54:2-3

Enlarge the place of your tent - speaks to **Vision** and **Scope** of Ministry (what you see in the Spirit, what the Spirit of God shows you and inspires within you, whatever you purpose to possess through **Obedience** to the Holy Spirit, God will give that territory, to you this year, as you **lay claim** to it and **Obey God's directives!** This territory can be people, places; things. **Enlarge your prayers...Your faith...and Your vision.**

Stretch your tent curtains wide, do not hold back - speaks to **Effort** and **Sacrifice** this year (Souls must be fought for, places, nations, cities, towns-must be penetrated the blessings of God must be claimed and possessed, by force, in the realm of the Spirit, through prayer and intercession, through faithful obedience, through travail and tears. However as you make the effort, and necessary sacrifices to possess the new territory God will open up this year, **You will succeed; You will succeed greatly!** So get ready...**Do not hold back; Do not limit God this year.** To the degree you are willing to be stretched by the Spirit of God; to that degree God will bless your ministry efforts this year. **UNITY** is the key this year...one can put a thousand to flight, two can put flight... 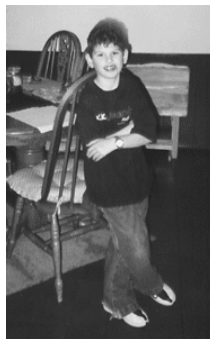

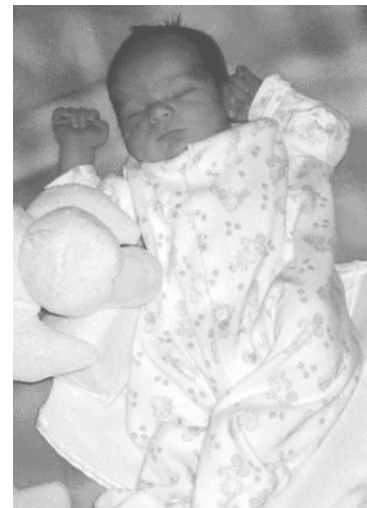
