Praise God for His Keeping Power!



Dear SGMM Partners, Family and Friends,

Greetings in the awesome name of Jesus Christ our precious Savior and Lord!

Many of you may not be aware so we want to tell you a little about our automobile accident the morning of February 20, 2005.

Jeff and Lisa left on Saturday Feb. 19th, for a week of vacation in Colorado, and we were blessed to have Joshua Will with us for the week. Our Conference Superintendent called us and asked if we could go to Enid to fill in at First Love, Feb. 20th for the AM and PM services, as the church is presently without a pastor. We agreed and as we were preparing to leave on Sunday morning, Rev. John began to load the keyboard and equipment in the Buick since we would not be taking the Gospel Coach out on this one day trip. The equipment, keyboard, etc. would not fit well in the Buick, so he moved everything into the Jeep. With the back loaded and the keyboard and stand between the front and back seat, we were ready to leave. Usually Joshua rides buckled up in the back seat, but because of the keyboard and all back there, we did not want it falling over on him during the trip, so Joshua and I switched places. I rode behind Rev. John in the back seat and Joshua Will was buckled in the front passenger seat.



Rev. John & I were talking about the day's appointment as we started out driving across the City and Joshua was singing "Holy, Holy, Jesus Lord". It was a beautiful sunny day. As we approached NW 150th intersection, Rev. John began slowing down for the light coming up, as we entered the intersection, all of a sudden John said, "Oh, My God"..."hold on".....I looked out the side window to the east and saw a very fast moving car ready to hit us on the passenger side of the Jeep. The next thing we knew, we were air born, (thrown upward into the air by the bumper and front of the car that hit us), and it seemed to me as if I began to go in all directions, as my seat belt had come unfastened, it was like I was in a clothes dryer. I heard Rev. John's voice every once in awhile, saying, "oh, oh, oh" every time we would hit something and during the time we were being flipped over. Several eye witnesses said that it appeared the young lady who hit us was possibly trying to beat the light, and was going so fast that on impact, she threw us into the air, we rolled over and came down on another car that was in the turn lane, came off of that car and rolled over again as we went back on to the highway, upside down, skidded about 50 feet and stopped.

When we stopped, Joshua was still secured in his seat by his seat belt, hanging upside down. Rev. John released Joshua's seat belt and with his one free arm, helped Joshua down. Praise be to God....Joshua did not have a scratch on him!!!! He was very frightened and wanted his Mama and Papa. Rev. John was trapped in his seat, and I had gone between the top and bottom of the back seat which had come apart, I felt terrible pain all on my left upper body, shoulder and arm and couldn't move. When the police, firemen, ambulance and all got there (later channel 4 TV. news crew), they discussed maybe having to cut me out, but finally got the back door pried open to take me out on a board. They had to break two front windows out to get Joshua and Rev. John pulled out. The hatch on the back of the Jeep had come open and everything was strung all over the highway and our ministry business cards were everywhere, even in the field nearby.

Rev. John told them to go ahead and take me to the hospital and he would wait for my sister Etta, to get there and they would come to the hospital. The aid in the ambulance helped me to phone First Love Church as they would be looking for us to arrive and I reported what had happened. Then I thought of Tony and Miranda Baker who lived on that side of town and tried to call them, got no answer, so called the church where they worship and asked the secretary to notify them of what had happened and ask them to come and get Joshua.

I was placed in the examining room in ER at Mercy Hospital, and just a few minutes later in walked Tony and Miranda. I asked them how they had gotten there so fast. Well, as the Lord was so with us in the vehicle we took that morning, and the seating arrangements of me and our Joshua Will, here God showed His Power again.....Miranda said that when she was praying that morning, she saw my keyboard case. Thought it was a little strange and then when they pulled out to go to church, Tony was directed to go a completely different way than he had ever gone before.....the way he took brought them right to the accident sight. Miranda said she saw it as they were approaching and told the kids to pray that there was a terrible wreck up ahead, then she saw the keyboard lying out in the road and said, "Tony, look someone in that car is a singer". Then she said, "Oh, my, that is Filese's keyboard, oh, that's Rev. John's Jeep." They talked to Rev. John and he had them take Joshua with them to the hospital while he waited for Etta to get there.

Rev. John, Joshua Will, the lady and baby to be in the car we came down on, and the young lady who hit us are all fine. Thanks Be to God!!!! I have 5 ribs broken, and my left shoulder bone is separated and pulled apart. The doctor told me that it will just take some time to heal. So I am a one arm servant right now, as my left arm is in a sling.

John & I, as well as our family, is absolutely vital.

We love you all so very much and appreciate you being in prayer on a CONSTANT BASIS for us and SGMM!!!!!!!

Also, keep Mother (Vesta) in prayer. We thank God for His keeping power of our parents and loved ones right now. Giving God ALL the thanks, praise and Glory!!!!

Inward Security Produces Outward Stability

Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in every way and that your body may be kept well,

even as I know your soul keeps well and prospers. That comes from 3 John 2, the amplified version, but it comes to each of you from me today. It is a personal prayer for you.

I've been doing a great deal of study for over a year on knowing my enemy. Why? Simple. It is my desire to be effective against him for the Lord's glory. If there is anything that I have been reminded of in recent weeks, it is that this is a warring ministry and I am a warrior. Added to that I am a teacher. Naturally my desire then is to pass on what I am learning so that you can be effective in warfare too. If you recoil at the very thought, then don't read on.

Credit for this short teaching goes to Roberts Liardon author of How to Survive an Attack.

The affect that you have for the Lord, for yourself or SGMM, is determined by how much your soul is prospering. The soul is comprised of your will, emotions, intellect, imagination, and memory. For this study the mind is broken into the last three categories. This month I want to simply focus on the will.

In any decision you make your will has the final say. All of the other areas of your soul have to align with your will. From the moment of being born-again, God intended for your will to be trained and disciplined by the Word. This results in you making choices that produce increase and abundance.

Satan's goal is to steal your will for God through passivity and lethargy. This basically means he wants to make you sluggish, inactive, drowsy, and dull. His strategy is through constant vexation and harassment. Review Samson and Delilah, and Joseph and Potiphar's wife.

Both men were vexed. Samson's body was strong but not his inner man. His accomplishments to that point did not help him. It wasn't his personal anointing that he needed to overcome the strategy of his enemies. Joseph however had to rely on the strength of God in his inner man. Surely it wasn't easy for him, in the natural, to resist the advances of Potiphar's wife.

God's will joined with our will equals strength which produces endurance and patience. Your outward circumstances don't have to be in alignment with the Word in order for your inner man to be in alignment. Inward security produces outward stability. So protect your will at all costs. You need a strong will to withstand the harassment and vexation when it comes.
