In Loving-Living Memory of Mama!

What a blessing our Mama has been to our lives. We are so thankful that she is home with her Lord, Daddy, Gran, Grandpa, and many other family and friends who arrived in Glory's big house, before her. But, oh, how we do miss her!! She left us a great testament and witness to God's honor and Mama is now free from pain, sorrow, suffering and Hallelujah!, her salvation and wholeness is now complete!

As Mama's children, grandchildren, great grandchildren, family and friends, gathered at the Parks Brothers Funeral Home, in Stroud, Ok., on Monday, March 28th, 2005, at 10:00 AM, to Celebrate her life, the presence of God was so powerfully with us. The family ministered the service to God's Glory and Mama's life. Rev. John shared some beautiful things about her journey here on the earth, our son and Mama's first grandchild, Jeff, read some loving, beautiful thoughts and memories, that each of the grandchildren had written, bringing tears to our eyes, and much laughter that filled our hearts. My sister Etta, sister-in-love Anne, and myself, led the congregation in Mama's favorite hymn, "Amazing Grace", and also delivered two of Mama's favorite songs, that she always loved to hear us kids sing years back when we traveled in ministry, or would get together around the piano, "I'M GOING TO HEAVEN" and "BUILD MY MANSION, NEXT DOOR TO JESUS". My brother, and SGMM Spiritual Advisor for many years now, Pastor John Youell, Sr., shared a message from God's Word, using Mama's favorite scriptures, and some wonderful stories of Mama and Daddy's life together, such as how God used Mama's choices to love the Lord and serve Him as Savior, to win Daddy to Christ and bring our entire family/house to the place in God and ministry where it is today. He closed the message by reading Mama's favorite poem, "Footprints In the Sand". My nephew, John

Youell, Jr., put a powerful sealing on Mama's Celebration Service, by singing, "IF YOU COULD SEE ME NOW".

Mama was named, Vesta Faye Drake when she was born, on March 6th, 1929, in Jennings, OK, to Orville Ora and Etta Olive (Morgan) Drake.

Mama was the next to youngest, and the only girl, of 4 children. In her growing up years, she was close to her parents, and her 3 brothers, Ervin, Willis, and Orville (Jr.), and was an honor student all through school. She always loved music, reading and was a cheerleader in high school. My Uncle Jr. shared with us that during basketball season, when the team would get behind on the score board, Mama would get out there and get the crowd going, to rev-up the team to bring them out and scoring the lead once again. Mama continued to encourage others and cheer for Jesus throughout the rest of her years and life on earth as well.

On March 20, 1946, Mama married Daddy, (Charles Youell), in Chandler, OK. Mama had seen Daddy's picture on the post office bulletin board, where they had placed several of the men's photo's from that area who were in the service at the time. She got Daddy's address and began to write to him. Daddy was somewhere out in the South Pacific and was at mail call one day. Mama's brother Ervin was stationed there with Daddy and was handing out the mail that day. Uncle Ervin handed Daddy this letter from Mama, with a photo of Mama enclosed. Daddy asks Uncle Ervin if he would like to see a picture of his girlfriend back home. Uncle Ervin looked at the photo and said, "Hey, that's my sister." It was quite an amazing coincidence at the time and of course Uncle Ervin and Daddy became acquainted and later brothers-in-love.

Mama and Daddy gave birth to three children, during their life on earth together, Filese (Phyllis) Loeva, Johnny Charles, and Etta Marie. Mama had accepted Jesus as her Savior and Lord at the age of 8, then re-committed her life and family to God, in 1952, at the 1st Assembly of God Church, in Ulysses, Kansas, where at the same time, Daddy, turned his life over to the Lord.

Throughout her life, Mama was a devoted wife, caring Mother, successful homemaker, and faithful church worker. She was very committed in her service to the Lord, and had a great love for the children and youth of her church.

Mama lived in Texas, New Mexico, Arizona, and then back in Oklahoma during her earthly journey. She and Daddy had lived close to 20 years in Bartlesville, OK, from 1981-2001, before they moved to Oklahoma City, where Mama resided for the past 4 years of her life after Daddy went home to be with the Lord, and was a member of The Crown Center where her son and grandson serve as pastors.

Both Mama and Daddy were so thankful that all of their children were taught of the Lord and chose to serve God in Ministry. Our parents (and grandparents of the grandchildren as well) were very supportive and very much a part of the front seat of our lives in the fulltime ministries of the Churches Pastored and of Son Grace Music Ministries. They were always challenging and encouraging the callings, talents, and giftings of God in all of our lives.

Heaven's choir was singing, and the bells were ringing, as the Holy Escort of Angles came to carry Mama back home to her Creator and Lord, on the beautiful morning of Pass Over/Good Friday, March 25th, at 10:00AM, in the anointed home of our brother and sister-in-love, John and Anne Youell, and with her family gathered around her, telling her to go on, and how much we loved her, Mama went home to be with her Lord, at the end of her 76 year pilgrimage here.

Vesta also is survived by 9 grandchildren and 7 great grandchildren, and a host of other family members and eternal friends.

Granny was always the mediator. I remember when Johnny & I were little and Papa would begin to give us a hard time about something and would begin to get louder and louder and Granny would come in and say, "Charles, you leave those boys alone!" Later, as Johnny & I became older, Papa would begin to give us a hard time about something, but we were then able to get right there with him and we would get louder and louder and Granny would come in and say, "You boys leave your Papa alone!" I always think of Granny with almost every memory of Papa, and until recent years, there was no Granny without Papa and there was no Papa without Granny.

When we started our Young Adult 24-7 Praise Service almost 3 years ago, I needed someone to help us in the nursery since we had quite a few young children coming. When I told Granny that we were having a hard time finding someone who could help us in the nursery, she didn't hesitate and said she would do it but I had to come get her before service and bring her to the church and take her home again afterwards because she didn't want to drive after dark. Even though the music was loud and I sometimes spoke longer than I was suppose to, she never complained, at least not to me.

I always think of Granny when I iron my clothes. A few years ago, I did some teaching in Bartlesville and I stayed

with Granny & Papa while I was there. Every morning, I would lay out my clothes to iron and ask Granny if she would get the iron ready for me so I could iron my clothes, and whenever I would come out from taking a shower, there my clothes would be, ironed and ready for me to put on. I never meant for her to iron them for me, but she always did. Papa also insisted that he drive me to work each day. It was a great time, spending it with my Granny & Papa.

One of the most important things to Granny was to always make sure we knew that God loved us and to teach us about Him. She was a strong woman of prayer!

Whenever I would take Joshua over to see Granny, which Joshua later changed her name to Mema, the first thing he would say as we walked in the door is, "I'm Hungry! I want crackers or I want gravy!" Mema would tell him, just a minute and he would run to the kitchen and start pulling out his favorite things Mema kept for him to eat. This happened so often that she began to ask him, "Doesn't your Mama ever feed you?" So, I made sure that he ate something immediately before we left for Mema's house. But, it never failed; he was hungry as soon as we arrived, five minutes later.

Joshua loved to take the books that Mema had for him and stack them end to end, all over the living room floor and use them for race tracks for his Hot Wheels, which Mema never minded, as long he picked them up, and for Mema, he would do it. Mema was the first one to teach him to do puzzles and he loved doing puzzles with her, even when we couldn't get him to sit still for five minutes, she could get him to sit and do puzzles.

Joshua loved going to Mema's house so much because when he was there, he got her undivided attention - and would tell Jeff and I to leave immediately because he wanted "his" time with her to read books, do puzzles, play cars or he loved doing her walking video.

Joshua asked me the day after Granny (Mema) went to be with the Lord, after he had time to process everything that had happened that day, he said, "Mema's gone?" "Yes, Joshua." "She went on the plane to be with Papa and Jesus?" "Yes, she did." "OK!" He was totally at ease because she was with Jesus & Papa now and he knows that one day, he'll see her again.

There are so many things I could touch on regarding how much the service meant to me, however, there is one point in particular that I feel is valuable to be put in writing for the continued celebration of both Charles and Vesta Youell.

Having attended both services and with Vesta's fresh in my mind, I want you all to know that I was challenged by the testimony of their lives and dedication to the Lord and family. Everything that was shared made me reflect on how I want my own life to be celebrated if I should pass before the Lord returns. I was challenged to rise to the standard that Vesta lived as a wife, mother, grandmother, great-grandmother and child of God. Her words of wisdom to trust the Lord and to visit (often) family, spoke volumes to me.

On my last visit with Vesta, I thanked her for being the matriarch of the family. I shared with her how her family had made an eternal impact on my family and my children. Our lives are with the Lord today because of her trust in the Lord all those years ago for her husband's salvation. From there the ripple has moved out to her children and beyond the Youell family to untold multiples of others. Only God knows from there the levels of ripples and other multiples of people whose eternal destinies were changed. Truly we are not islands unto ourselves and our lives do have impact.

I did share with Etta at the service that the mantle has now been passed. Each of you three children is now the patriarch and matriarchs of your own households. You have been given the tools that you need to carry on to God's glory. You can and are doing it. You are still impacting your own children and grandchildren. Your prayers alone for them are valuable. How you live your lives out to complete your journey is teaching.

Thank you for allowing me to feel such a part of the family these 14 years. There have been so many things that I have felt privileged to go through with you, joys and sorrows. In some small way, I pray that I have been a blessing back to your family. It would be my way of continually showing my thankfulness.

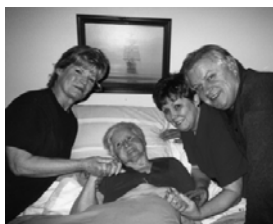
