The Word from the Back 40!

Weapon of mass destruction!

We as a part of the body of Christ are a weapon of mass destruction against the enemy. Instead of us looking at the devil as some big giant we need to realize because we are in Christ, the giant being looked at is Christ in us and the devil is under our feet.

To many times we see the enemy coming out against us as a mountain of a problem instead of looking at it from God's point of view that there is nothing that has come our way that Jesus has not already experienced and defeated. Our circumstances are not 'unique', but the scripture says nothing has taken us but that it is common to man [1 Corinthians 10:13].

Romans 8:15-17 tells us that we have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear but we have received the spirit of adoption and that we are heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ and 31 says because God is for me, who can be against me. Our mind set has to be based on what God is saying instead of what we are experiencing if our experience is contrary to the revelation of God.

David in 1 Samuel 17:45-47 declared his position as to what God was going to do to the enemy in the face of 40 days of taunting by Goliath.

Jesus in John 14:10 said that because He was in the Father and the Father was in Him, that the words that He spoke were not words of his own doing, but that the words were from the Father, and it was the Father's responsibility to bring them to pass, HE DOETH THE WORK. In John 14:12 Jesus declared that the works He did we would do also and greater works because He has gone to the Father. When Jesus said it was the Father who doeth the works and because we are in Christ, we have to be settled in the truth that He will do the works He tells us to do. Mark 16:15-20 the commission to declare the Gospel and He said he would confirm the word, just as He did for the early church.

CT version John 14:10&12 I believe that I am in Christ and Christ is in me! The words that I speak, I speak not of myself: but Jesus that dwelleth in me, He doeth the works.

CT version John 4:30 I can do nothing of myself: as I hear [John 10:27], I do and my Father bears witness. Therefore Phil 4:13--I can do all things through Christ who gives me the strength. Strongs: strengtheneth: endunamoo--to empower. This comes from the root word dunamis--inherent ability that we are born with, or another way to say it is God's DNA flowing through us causing us to have the ability and empowerment to cause to come to pass.

We are not going to someday be a weapon of mass destruction, we are now. Because we are this individually, look what we can do as the body of Christ. Don't be intimidated and draw back but let us be aggressive and put the enemy on the run.

The Captain's Corner

Dear Family, Friends, and Partners,

My greetings to you today on this National Day of Prayer. May you experience the fullness of the presence of the Lord in all areas of your lives.

This month I wish to continue my study on How to Survive an Attack by Roberts Liardon. The last time I wrote we looked at the will under attack. Today we will look at the emotions.

Our emotions are not something to fear nor are they to rule us or determine the path of our destiny. They allow us to express the character of God when our spirit is leading. Let our flesh lead and our emotions will keep us in confusion. You know, like a roller coaster- up and down, up and down. For us as believers, the good news is that our spirit man has the final say not our emotions. You see, if Satan cannot get to us through our wills (March article) he will try to gain entrance through our emotions. This in turn weakens our will.

How do we know if our emotions are under attack? One sure sign is self-pity. We've all been there. When we look through the eyes of self-pity our view is severely distorted. Another sign is anger which leads to bitterness. When our emotions are under attack we begin to feel like everyone is against us or everyone else is wrong and we're right. We may feel alone and isolated. Our thoughts may dwell on revenge. We focus on what we see in the natural.

No matter what is happening in the natural, freedom from an emotional attack comes from exalting the Word of God above the circumstance. It is our choice. It was provided to us as a weapon, but the Holy Spirit does not force us to wield it. We have David as an example of one who knew how to exalt the Word when he was under emotional attack. The Psalms are full of phrases that he used to build himself up.

Now I have written all of that to share this with you. As the prayer captain for this ministry, I am aware of many of the circumstances that your households are facing. I know

that for many this has not yet been a refreshing, joyful year as the Word for 2005 has promised. But hold on. When I look in the Bible for instances where joy broke out among the people of God, I see that it was usually after a battle of some sort. Like you, I don't want to hear that. I get discouraged sometimes just by reason of my position as prayer captain. My emotions want to lead my spirit. But, I look to the Word of God and the Word for SGMM to be my final authority. Usually I don't understand why God's people are experiencing one trial or another. I struggle with the "why" question at times.

What I want to accomplish today is to put you in remembrance of the Word. If you are experiencing the symptoms of an emotional attack, pick up the Word. It is high time that we exalt the Word over our feelings, our distorted vision, our questions of "why" or "how" or even "when"! Exalt the Word for 2005 over any cursed thing. Exalt God and expect miracles to take place. Exalt the Word over the powers of darkness. The Word tells us that anyone who wants to can come. Did you get that? Anyone who WANTS to can come. If your flesh is ruling your emotions, you may not want to do anything. Staying in bed and pulling the covers over your head may seem like a better option.

This branch of the ministry, the prayer office, was created for you to have an outlet to reach out for prayer, encouragement, etc. The annual Word Conference was created for you. Beside the different speakers that we have, the Word for the New Year is released on that day. It would be easier to just have Rev. John Youell type it up and mail it to Rev. John and Filese. The point isn't just for them to have it. This Word is for you and me, our families, all that concerns us. Many of you have your own ministries with your own visions and work for the Lord. But you are made stronger by partnering with us and us with you. Isn't that why tribes would form covenants, for strength?

Thank God many of you take the time to teach in to provide the same prayer power, encouragement, love, and support to us. See friends, this is how we all survive an attack. We reach out to one another. We pray. We exalt the Word of the Lord above all else. When circumstances show us weak areas that need to be tightened, we do the necessary work. We DO NOT isolate, blame, retaliate, crumble, or walk away from our destinies. WE DO NOT! WE DO NOT! WE DO NOT!

I thank God for each one of you. The outpouring of love and concern since the accident and Vesta's homecoming has been phenomenal. You have demonstrated exactly what I have tried to express in this article. Our prayer is that we always exemplify this to you as well. I truly believe that living in victory means that we simply continue onward and upward toward the high calling of God in Christ Jesus, no matter what, with God's help and each other.

Key Scripture: Isaiah 60:1

Key word: "Arise" – The year 2003 will be a year of PROMOTION for this ministry.

I hear the Spirit of the Lord saying to SGMM, "Because you have been faithful with a few things, I will put you in charge of many things." (Matthew 25:21)

Because you have been faithful through your honesty and integrity – promotion will come to you – this ministry will rise to a new level. 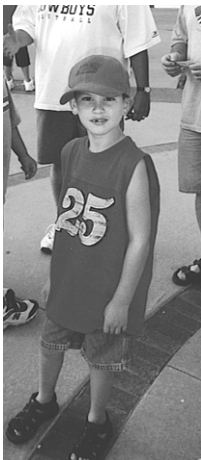
