Regret Robs You of Your Joy!

It happened as easily as a casual reading here, a casual reading there. Then BOOM, it hits me, God is speaking to my heart about me. So "casually" He used seemingly simple things to convey a deep illumination of the power of the regrets that I had in my life. The Random House Dictionary defines regret as: to feel sorrow or distress for (a wrong or a fault); to think of with a sense of loss; sorrow or distress for a fault, mistake, etc. The meaning of regret was not lost to my understanding. It is safe to say that we all know what we regret. What had been lost to me was that I could do something about that which I regretted.

This day was different. First, I realized that I was living in regret and that it had power over my day-to-day life. What I regretted isn't important, but what I did with them is. It took some literal soul searching as far back as I could possibly remember. Even things I could not remember, but had knowledge of, had to be dragged out of the dusty chasms of my mind.

His instructions were not complicated. "Let go of your regrets and celebrate." And I did, one by one. At first I

wasn't sure how to celebrate after releasing a loss. I really just did it out of obedience. The logical thing seemed to be to think of the positives connected to each regret. For example, I regretted not finishing college. In turn I celebrated the fact that I was still used by God to touch many children's lives as a teacher for 7 years. This includes my own children. Currently I am home-schooling my youngest. And so I went, release then celebrate.

What truly amazes me even now, days later, is that the process was not painful. No tears were shed. It was all so matter-of-fact. There was no shame either. But there was JOY! It was wonderful. Releasing those regrets released joy to my soul.

Common sense would dictate that this would be the end result. For me the regrets were revealed (revelation). I knew I had regrets. The illumination that came to the revelation allowed me to see the power of the regrets over my life. And it allowed me to understand how to be victorious over them through celebration. This in turn brought refreshment (joy) to my soul.

Immediately pandemonium was sent against my home, but it was too late. Revelation and illumination had already been released and change had occurred to such a degree that darkness could not penetrate the light of God's love. Illumination was sent again and another wave of joy was released into my home. This is a picture of revival.

This is exactly what the Word for 2005 promises. This is the year of the widened eye! Keep praying and watching over it for SGMM and your lives. Watch for it, it's coming. Indeed it's already here! Remember too that regrets steal your joy.

What's Up with this Greed?

What's Up with these Greedy desires that lead to Coveting so rap pent these days?

If you get up from these things you will go down with them.

Greed - -An excessive desire for more than one needs or deserves.

Covet - To desire that which is rightfully another's.

COVETOUSNESS - Nelson's Bible Dictionary

An intense desire to possess something (or someone) that belongs to another person. The Ten Commandments prohibit this attitude (Ex 20:17; Deut 5:21). Covetousness springs from a greedy self-centeredness and an arrogant disregard of God's law. The Bible repeatedly warns against this sin (Josh 7:21; Rom 7:7; 2 Peter 2:10).

Many examples of covetousness appear in the Bible: Gehazi's greed (2 Kings 5:20-27), Judas' betrayal of Jesus (Matt 26:14-15), the rich fool (Luke 12:13-21), the rich young ruler (Luke 18:18-25), and the deceit of Ananias and Sapphira (Acts 5:1-11). The apostle Paul labeled this sin as idolatry (Col 3:5). He warned believers not to associate with a covetous brother (1 Corinthians 5:10-11).

The best way to avoid a self-centered, covetous attitude is to trust the Lord and to face one's responsibilities (Gal 6:7-9; 2 Thessalonians 3:6-15). To those tempted by "covetousness" and "worthless things" (Ps 119:36), Jesus declares, "Take heed and beware of covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the abundance of the things he possesses" (Luke 12:15).

Luke 12:13-15

13 Someone in the crowd said to him, "Teacher, tell my brother to divide the inheritance with me." 14 Jesus replied, "Man, who appointed me a judge or an arbiter between you?" 15 Then he said to them, "Watch out! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; a man's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions."

Isa 57:17

17 I was enraged by his(man's) sinful greed; I punished him, and hid my face in anger, yet he kept on in his willful ways.

Matt 23:25-26

25 "Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You clean the outside of the cup and dish, but inside they are full of greed and self-indulgence. 26 Blind Pharisee! First clean the inside of the cup and dish, and then the outside also will be clean.

Eph 5:2-3

3 But among you there must not be even a hint of sexual immorality, or of any kind of impurity, or of greed, because these are improper for God's holy people.

Col 3:5-8

5 Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry. 6 Because of these, the wrath of God is coming. 7 You used to walk in these ways, in the life you once lived.

The world, for the most part is ruled by greed and covetousness. But, what is worst is that the church is also being contaminated by this same materialism.

For several months, the Lord seemed to open my eyes to the level of dissatisfaction and worldly greed I saw all around me. I expected it from the worldly people. That did not surprise me. But the same spirit is ruling many Christian people. That scares me. It is one more distraction from the true calling the Lord has given the church.

Now, many of the words in the Bible translated greed are more accurately describing covetousness. But greed itself, which is a strong desire or lust for something other than one has, is wrong and ungodly when it displaces or dominates our focus, our priority and attention that God alone deserves.

We seem to keep repeating the sins of our forefathers, that is, worshipping the gift as higher than the creator. But covetousness is worse, in that it involves the desire for what another person has. It is a threat, not only in temptation to be selfish but a threat to another's possessions which we do not have a right to.

The whole problem with greed and covetousness is that it usurps the authority and the priority that is first, of God being our source and comfort, second, the calling and nature of a Christian to be like God in generosity and a creative giver and finally the peace and joy we should selflessly have when we see another blessed, even in ways we appear not to yet be blessed.

We know how the world acts. We know the evil present in these end days. But are we not to be different? Are we not called out of this world system, set aside for a higher calling? How will the world know that is a God present in the midst of such selfishness if the Body of Christ lives merely like the world?

Are you called to be sanctified? Will you answer the call to serve God rather than mammon? You see, we can not keep trying to serve two masters. If we serve God, we will find more of His goodness and yes, He will bless. If we serve self, we will only find more of self. I don't know

about you but I am disgusted with the Body of Christ trying to live a life married to two husbands.
