WORD OF THE LORD FOR SON GRACE MINISTRIES FOR 2006

Delivered through Pastor John Youell – Spiritual Advisor
Key Scripture Reference for 2006 - **Acts 3:1-10**

FOUNDATIONAL THINGS SON GRACE ALREADY KNOWS AND IS ESTABLISHED IN:

- Son Grace is a mobile ministry, under the direct scrutiny of the Holy Spirit. (You minister as you move and move as you minister). The coach is visible evidence of this fact.
- Son Grace's effectiveness rests on a foundation of prayer. Prayer is the foundation and prayer is the structure upon which the success of this ministry rests. Miranda Baker and the intercessory prayer team is visible evidence of this.
- Son Grace's purpose is to promote Christ and realizes that the power and effectiveness of this ministry rests solely in the Name of Jesus and the activity of the Holy Spirit. Your purpose is to proclaim the Good News of Christ and see lives transformed by the power of the Holy Spirit. Testimonies from pastors and individuals who experience the effectiveness of the Word of God through this ministry are visible evidence of this.
- Joy and Son Grace go together. The joy of the Lord is not only the strength of this ministry; it is one of the primary evidences of this ministry's effectiveness. Joy in the hearts of pastors and people who receive your ministry is evidence of this. Expect the joy level to keep rising!



Now, some specifics regarding the future of this ministry revealed through this story is:

UNITY - ("Peter and John") – (not sameness – but moving together in the same direction to accomplish the same purposes.)

- Starts with John & Filese
- Encompasses entire Son Grace team
- Embraces pastors of churches whose area you travel into to minister (or group of pastors who network together to impact their town or city.)

NETWORKING – (there is strength in numbers) - Pray toward and expect more churches to come together to form a unified front to effect their area for Christ.

PRAY MORE SPECIFICALLY TOWARD THIS UNIFIED/ NETWORKING FRONT TO BE ESTABLISHED IN THE AREAS YOU TRAVEL INTO IN 2006.

- God has given you key pastors in various areas – believe God to use these key pastors to bring other pastors and churches together for more territorial meetings this year.

TIMING – ("at the time of prayer") – Remember this is God's ministry. Trust in His timing and expect His order. You may even find, this year, things adjusting somewhat on the fly – meaning that, although you have meetings and or appointments set up at for certain times, don't become anxious if some get re-arranged throughout the year.

- Trust in God's orchestration – in putting things together at His time and in His way for His purposes. God is adjusting things in the Body of Christ and that includes His ministries and His appointments.
- Go with God – flow with Him – be aware that only those who move with God, at His time and in His way, are going to be in a position to be used by Him.
- So far Son Grace has walked with military boots on – methodically marching along taking territory for God – but I hear the Holy Spirit saying, "put skates on your feet" and get ready for acceleration and movement to the right and the left – be quick to respond and transition as God directs you this year.

VISIBILITY – "Look at us – so the man gave them his attention, expecting to get something from them."

- God is continuing to position this ministry to be seen – to be visible - to be looked at and looked upon to accomplish specific things for the Lord's Kingdom.
- God wants to turn the spotlight more on this ministry. Don't be afraid to say "look at us!" – not with human arrogance and pride, but with spiritual confidence and obedience – God wants to place you more and more in the forefront, because he has tested and tried you – sifted and purified you over the years – and you have proved faithful.
- So, anticipate new opportunities to come to you and don't be reluctant to promote what God has done and will do through this ministry to those who will open their territory to it.

EXPECTANCY - Expect a heightened level of anticipation and expectancy in people's hearts this year – for the needs are great.

- People who have looked to other sources and not found what they were hoping for, will begin to look to Son Grace this year – some will come out of the occult, some will come out of other religions – they will turn and find in the ministry of Son Grace what they have been searching for.

EFFECTIVENESS - "what I have I give you" – God has and will continue to deposit into this ministry specific gifts and abilities which will meet the needs of people as ministry flows through out of Son Grace through prayer, songs and the ministry of the Word. (Word of the Lord - cont'd)

- Continue to believe for God to equip you with what is needed as you go out to minister – for He will deposit in you what He determines to produce through you.
- Also, anticipate new connections (networking again) with people and other ministries to more fully equip this ministry to be strategically used by God in 2006.
- New people – new places – new gifting – new tools to equip you to do the work of ministry God is calling this ministry to accomplish this year and in years to come.
- God is going to give you some new things (people, places, tools, connections, etc) this year – which will set up things for the ministry in coming years.

SIGNS, WONDERS AND MIRACLES – “He jumped to his feet and began to walk” – Continue to pray toward and expect the miraculous touch of God upon this ministry and to be manifested through this ministry to others.

- There will be times this year, where power encounters will take place and your vindication as a ministry in the hand of God will be the manifestation and demonstration of the Holy Spirit in gifts of power.
- The farther you go (in ministry) the higher you go (in visibility) the more effective you will need to be and the more you can anticipate the power of the Holy Spirit to be manifested through your life and ministry. The supernatural is to mark this ministry more and more in the future.

2006 will bring some ADJUSTMENTS to the ministry (so become more flexible); it will bring ADDITIONS to the ministry (in people, places, and tools); it will bring ADVANCEMENT to the ministry (in visibility and effectiveness).

That means don't wait for someone else to tell us about your surgery that took place weeks ago. Let us help you sandbag with prayer. Don't go through weeks of depression before you call for some backup. Truthfully, I find that it is usually pride that keeps me from reaching out for prayer. Much mental and physical energy is expended when we try to put our pinky in the levee to keep it plugged all by our lonesome selves.

Hopefully I will be bombarded with your requests for prayer. I can't believe I even typed that. However, that's just where it's at. As I put myself out there for further use by God, I am also believing for Him to call some of you and others to include my name in your prayers for SGMM. My name is in the Word, as well as our Intercessory Prayer Team, so please see that as a call to begin to lift me and this prayer office up regularly. I am advancing in my calling and office and know that I need my name included right there with Rev. John and Filese I need more revelation, illumination, wisdom, and discernment as I endeavor to be effective for you and the ministry. Please also continue to keep covered in prayer our spiritual advisor Rev. John Youell & family, Jeff, Lisa & Joshua and our SGMM Advisory Board Members. Thank you so much.
