

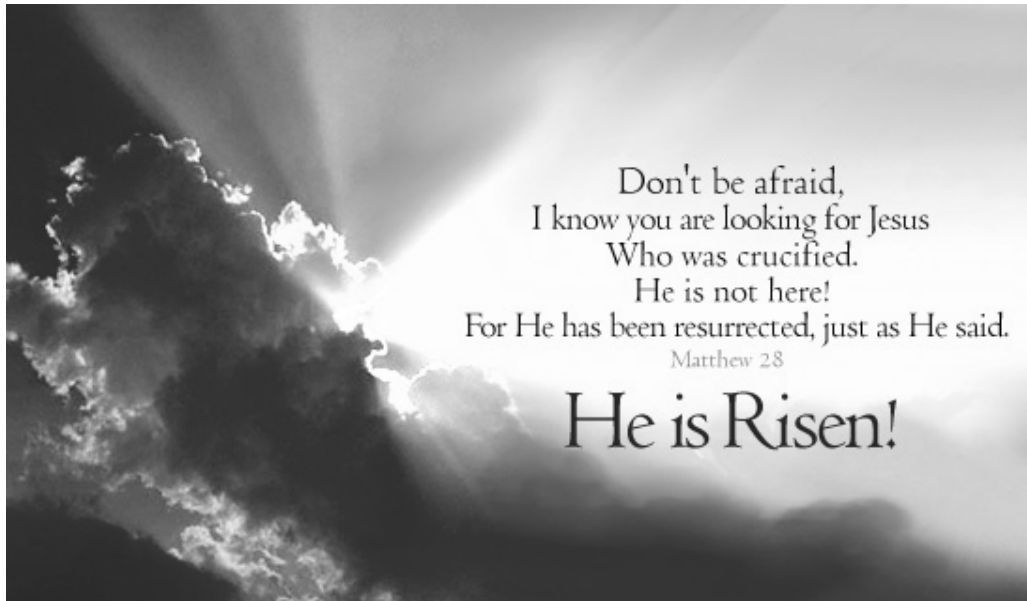

Re-sur-rect means to restore to life, to bring to view AGAIN the act or fact of rising AGAIN from an inferior state, such as death, decay, or mis-use. Rising from an inferior state to a higher place!

RE means to do again...you can't re-do anything that you haven't done before, or already done

To do something AGAIN is not to do it OVER. Because OVER means repetition, which does not denote life. Over can mean to end or to finish. AGAIN points toward an opposite direction, meaning FURTHER or IN ADDITION.

RESURRECTION is RESURGENCE (rising AGAIN to life, activity, or prominence)

RESURRECTION is a STEP FORWARD or UPWARD, MOVEMENT or ACTION..."MORE"
