### **The Journey Toward Healing**

**After many years in ministry I have begun to see less healing among Christians and more acceptance, excuses and unbelief in dealing with sickness, infirmity and limited physical conditions. This has troubled me, especially since I too have been one of those accepting such limitations. So, I have decided to renew my faith and thought processes and speech (confession) about healing through the only source of authority and confidence I know which will last, the Word of God.**

**I believe many of us have begun to trust in our current perception of reality and our personal experience about the healing or lack of it in ourselves and others rather than trust in the Word of God and His Redemptive work. This journey may take some time, since our current thoughts and beliefs took time to develop to the point we are at.**

If you too, have begun to struggle in this area or have always struggled, take this faith journey with me. Get yourself a notebook or open a new computer file and start compiling the truth about healing – allowing your faith to grow and your decisions to change the way you live and respond to the need for healing in your mind and/or your body.

Romans 12:2 says, “and do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.” KJV

I believe this journey's effect will begin the mind, our mind, our understanding, our way of looking at and speaking about healing. Once we renew our mind, that is understand, agree and accept what God had done, wants for us and says about us, we will be transformed by the power of the Holy Spirit. We will begin to act like we believe God. We will begin to act on what God says. We will begin to exercise our trust in God and the integrity of His Word. I have heard it said and have shared many times in ministry, “When God can get it through you (your

head), God can get it to you.” Only when we submit our souls (mind, will and emotions) to the authority of God’s Word, will the Holy Spirit be able to get the benefits of God’s healing covenant with us.

First, as I already stated, we must choose to believe God, taking Him at His Word, trusting His authority and reality rather than our own feelings, experiences or the conclusions we have drawn from life around us.

Second we must understand the distinction between the Old and New Testaments that we have in our Christian Bible. The covenants, limitations, conditions and application of Grace God has provided for us in the creation are particular to the times, people and faith of those involved. The Old Testament is a different covenant and applies to different people of faith than the New Testament. That is why they are named differently.

Although the Old Testament is a Revelation in type, of God’s plan and promises, it is not the same as the New Testament. The Old Testament is a matter of law, pointing to the holiness of God and the need for Salvation of humankind through the goodness of God by the temporal acts of fulfilling covenants, including sacrifices of animals and adherence to the other regulations of God contained in the Old Testament. This was to be done through a Chosen People of God as a conduit of blessing by preparing the world for the coming of the Messiah, as foretold in the Old Testament.

The New Testament is a matter of Grace through Faith, you cannot say, as a Christian, “We must sacrifice certain unblemished animals, certain times of the year and keep other regulations of the Old Testament in order to receive God’s blessings.”

The New Testament itself tells us, “23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; 24 Being justified freely by His Grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: 25 Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in His blood, to declare His righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God; 26 to declare, I say, at this time His righteousness: that He might be just, and the justifier of Him which believeth in Jesus. 27 Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? Of works? Nay: but by the law of Faith. 28 Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by Faith without the deeds of law.” Romans 3:23-28 KJV

“10 For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all.” James 2:10 KJV

Since none of humanity have kept the whole law, save Jesus the Christ, no one can claim the blessings of God through the law, save as it was fulfilled in Christ’s death and resurrection. If we kept the whole law perfectly, we would be eligible for the benefits of Old Testament covenant. But, we have not and I believe, cannot in and of ourselves.

So, the New Testament is the fulfillment of the law, through Christ and the message of invitation to any who will receive His righteousness by faith and the other provisions He paid for. The New Testament is a different kind of covenant, if you will, based solely on submitting to and embracing by faith, what God did through Jesus Christ to fulfill the requirements of righteousness making salvation an inheritance of Christ, not a wage we earned by keeping the law. And, as we will discover or at least renew our minds, healing is a part of the promises, blessings and inheritance of those who trust in Christ Jesus for Salvation.

Thirdly, we must identify the promises of healing contained in the Old and New Testament which have been fulfilled by Christ and submit to those promises as the Word and faithfulness of God. Then we begin to identify with the one who became a curse for us, taking our infirmities and bore our sicknesses. Matthew 8:17 KJV

And lastly, begin to speak and act in the faith of Christ, the anointed one, upon the righteousness of God and the promises He has given to us.

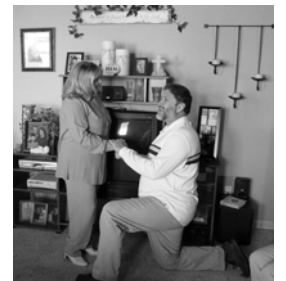

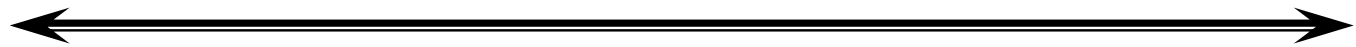
