The Journey Toward Healing III



I was recently reminded of an error in the modern church when praying for healing. Many people pray, asking God to heal. Some do this because of the teaching they have received, some, who question their authority or their faith, pray in this manner. In the Old Testament, the conditions for healing were offered by an instrument of God and if these were met, healing was manifested.

In the New Testament healing was done through an instrument of God, either by response to a request by someone in need or by a work of faith exercised by an instrument of God or by the direction of the Holy Spirit through that instrument. But the point is that healing almost always manifested through the actions of a vessel of God, not ordinarily by praying to God to respond to a need.

Now, Jesus was the Son of God, yet He accomplished the works of God on earth, only through the authority of the Father given Him and only through the power of the Holy Spirit. Jesus had the fullness of the Holy Spirit and that power was the key to His acts of faith in obedience to his Father.

I believe Christ (the anointed one), fulfilled his ministry of faith, obedience and sacrifice on this earth as the only righteous vessel capable of carrying out the cost of our inheritance. Then, He said, that we would do the same works as He and even greater works, feats and exploits in ministry to others, collectively because He was going to the Father and then send the Holy Spirit to us as the promised gift from Heaven.

Christ Jesus, having received authority from the Father and exercising the power through the Holy Spirit to fulfill God's plan gave us, those who believe in Him, the power, through the Holy Spirit, to heal.

*"And when He had called His twelve disciples to Him, He gave them power over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease."
Matt 10:1*

"Then He appointed twelve, that they might be with Him and that He might send them out to preach, and to have power to heal sicknesses and to cast out demons."

Mark 3:14-15

Now the prayer of Jesus recorded in the Gospel according to John, was not just for the twelve, but for all who would believe because of them. We are all called a part of the Body of the Anointed One (Christ). Although we each have different gifts, offices and calling, we are all a part of The Body.

Second, He commanded us to heal. Again, just as the head healed all who came to him, the body is commanded to do this and even greater works, because of the anointing working through all who believe collectively.

"And as you go, preach, saying, 'The kingdom of heaven is at hand. Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. Freely you have received, freely give.'" Matt. 10:7-8

"And heal the sick there, and say to them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you.'" Luke 10:9

When Christ Jesus gave the Church, His Body, the Great Commission at His ascension, He was including all the works that He did as the Head of the Body.

"The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to release the oppressed, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor." Luke 4:18-19

"He sent them to preach the kingdom of God and to heal the sick."

Luke 9:2

"Calling the Twelve to him, he sent them out two by two and gave them authority over evil spirits." Mark 6:7 "They went out and preached that people should repent. 13 They drove out many demons and anointed many sick people with oil and healed them." Mark 6:12-13

We need to stop acting like we must beg God to do, even that, which we would do out of compassion for someone else. We need to do the works of Jesus, as His Body because He gave us the power, He gave us the command, and He sent us to fulfill His will. That is, to glorify God, carry out the

destruction of Satan's works and bless the creation of God with the Gospel. The Gospel is the Good News of Salvation. Salvation means deliverance and healing from the lack of wholeness and destruction created sin and evil.

We need to acknowledge God in all things, that He would direct our paths. But we need not wonder about the plan or will of God, nor wait, if any He is slow in answering our prayers. We need to be the instrument of God, in fulfilling the character and power of His son and act upon the authority of His Word, the power of the Holy Spirit and the faith we have in Him to pray for the healing of others.

And prayer is not only talking to God. Prayer is agreeing with God and acting on His Word.
