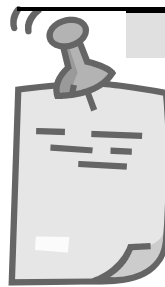
Thank you for surrounding us with the Lord and preparing His way of healing within John.

The Captain's Corner

Dear Prayer Partners and Friends,

I greet you today in the name of Jesus the Lord. It is my prayer that you are in joy these summer months, despite the heat. I'm sure that heat has come in many forms not even related to temperature. Let me encourage you. Take the time to reflect on the many people who endured the pressure of their circumstances; people like Joseph, Job, Daniel, Paul, even Jesus.

These familiar accounts serve to remind us to be patient in the times of press. In the midst of the pressure they experienced, they continued to trust the integrity of God's word. It's much like adding resistance training to your exercise regime. The muscles respond to the resistance. First the muscle slightly breaks down so that it can be built back to a stronger and more flexible state.

If I am using a hand weight to work my deltoid, it is good to lift the weight repeatedly. It's a better workout if I resist myself when doing the lifts. Granted this analogy only goes so far, but apply it to James 4:7. "Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you." Resist is translated from the Greek word *anthistemi*. It's the same word translated as withstand in Ephesians 6:13. It suggests vigorously opposing, bravely resisting, standing face-to-face against an adversary, standing your ground. I believe that we often see resisting the devil as running. We may stand and deny his right to come against us, but do we turn to face him and actually press back?

It's time for Satan to feel more of the heat than God's people. Submit yourself to God but turning to face the enemy and releasing the Word from your mouth. Now don't mix it with words that aren't the integrity of the Word. Every time we do that we turn back to run and the heat is back on us. Keep pushing and resisting with patience and pretty soon you will have some spiritual muscle built up.

The Journey Toward Healing

III

"And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus." Phil 4:7 KJV

Sometime toward the end of my second Wednesday night teaching on Healing at The Crown Center this last month, I heard God say that Peace was essential for healing to take place. After reviewing that nights recording to copy the message, I heard myself begin the teaching in a prayer which stated almost the same thing. I had not been aware that I had prayed about this subject. I believe it was God, trying to show us the importance of peace.

And then, after considering what I would share about peace, I remembered several items I mentioned in my second Newsletter article on the Journey Toward Healing. I believe they are parts of this peace we must have, to experience the healing of our bodies and mind.

What is peace?

PEACE - (pes) (shalom; eirene): Is a condition of freedom from disturbance, whether outwardly, as of a nation from war or enemies, or inwardly, within the soul. (from *International Standard Bible Encyclopedia, Electronic Database Copyright (c)1996 by Biblsoft*)

"Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee."
Isa 26:3 KJV

First, we need peace with God, but not just a legal relationship with God through the acceptance of Christ. Instead, peace that comes as we have fellowship with God. Now, to have fellowship with God we must be free of any condemnation or known offence against God. Even as Christians, we can not have peace when we are willfully guilty of trespasses against God.

When we are guilty our hearts condemn us. We may try to justify our actions or attitude. Or, we may try blaming others for our fault. And, of course, either way, the accuser of the brethren tries to cause us total defeat by tempting us to give up on our hope for reconciliation. Or, he may attempt getting us to accuse God, with the thoughts that life is too hard or that it is impossible to succeed in this journey of faith.

However, we know that, God is faithful, and is willing to forgive us and cleanse us from all unrighteousness, when we confess our wrong and submit our guilt to the sacrifice of Jesus. Our peace with God does not require a perfect life. It requires our fellowship with God through the continued application of His grace and faith that we do not have

to continue in the bondage of sin, subject to condemnation, without hope of chance.

Second, we need peace with ourselves. If we do not deny pride and admit our failures, we will not apply the grace of God to our lives and forgive ourselves as Christ has forgiven us. When we violate that which we see as wrong or let ourselves down, we find fault with ourselves. We can offend ourselves just like we can wrong others. But we have a harder time seeing this and a harder time knowing what to do about it. So, we justify ourselves and hate ourselves and deny that there is a problem.

The grace of God that we receive through Christ is like anything else. We must receive and apply that grace for it to serve its purpose. If we do not apply the grace we have received, we cannot walk in the peace that God intends for us to experience. We must acknowledge our disappointments, our failures and our trespasses against ourselves and choose to do that which Christ provided, forgive, release from judgment and bless.

Stop judging, rejecting and hating yourself; that is not God's plan. Apply the blood Christ shed for you and release the offense, the failure, the disappointment. Get back to serving God by accepting yourself as God does.

Thirdly, we need peace with each other. When we begin to forgive one another and accept each other based on God's provision and purpose we show that we are one in the Spirit and all part of the same body, the Body of Christ. Jesus was very clear on this matter. Either we choose to forgive others their sins, their shortcoming, their trespasses against us or we can not receive the forgiveness we need.

But, when we do apply the blood of the lamb to the sins of others, like the priest does, we will experience God's purpose fulfilled, receiving healing in our lives. This is a calling to a Royal Priesthood. It is a way of life. It is part of the means to healing flowing in our life.

When we are at peace with God, forgiven and accepting of who we are in Christ and learning how we are to relate and to belong to each other, we are open to emotional restoration, singleness of mind (no torment) and the flow of supernatural healing power in and through our bodies.

Lastly, we need peace that comes to us through our trust and reliance upon God and the integrity of His Word. As we recount the ways, the Will and the Word of God, primarily found in the Bible, we find peace that surpasses all understanding. We realize the goodness of God and the reliability we find in Him. This, not only comforts us, but strengthens our faith and assurance that God is for us. So, who can stand against us, as we are clothed in His righteousness?

Reading, professing and doing the Word of God results in the peace that releases healing power in our lives. Not even sickness can rule and reign when God's peace is our covering.

Now, the application of these different kinds of peace which, all help release healing is a perpetual thing, a lifestyle, a way of living in relationship with God, ourselves and others. As we allow this peace to overshadow us, healing is allowed to flow. It is allowed to complete the work Christ, Jesus paid for through his life and death on this earth.

Enter into peace and walk in the wholeness that God has provided for you.
