**The Journey Toward
 Healing VI
 SPEAK TO YOUR BODY**

For several months I have been dealing with certain ailments and symptoms of pain and discomfort. In praying about these issues I kept running into walls with my faith. It seemed that I could only go so far in believing for the manifested healing I needed. Now, in trying to heal with my own need for manifested healing and because I witnessed so much need in others around me, I have tried to systematically research and teach on this subject. And I believe it is time to "speak to

the problem." Because of the ministry and sacrifice of Jesus, we have the legal right to be healed. It is our inheritance as the redeemed of God.

"But he was wounded for our transgressions; he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed." Isa 53:5 KJV

"And when he had given thanks, he brake it, and said, Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me." 1 Cor 11:24 KJV

We have been given the authority to act in the name of Jesus to bless others by policing the evil results of the curse, because Jesus became a curse for us.

"When a strong man armed keepeth his palace, his goods are in peace: 22 But when a stronger than he shall come upon him, and overcome him, he taketh from him all his armor wherein he trusted, and divideth his spoils. 23 He that is not with me is against me: and he that gathereth not with me scattereth." Luke 11:21-22 KJV

Christ, Jesus broke the back of the evil one through his life of obedience, death of sacrificial love and resurrection power because of His righteousness. We are to act upon what He has done, for we are His body. We are to spoil the goods of the wicked and set the captive free.

"And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven." Matt 16:19 KJV

We are not left comfortless. We are not on our own. Christ has given us another comforter and the power to be a witness for him. We have His authority. He desires us to act in his name.

23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them." Mark 11:21-24 KJV

If only we would believe, then anything we need to obey the Lord is in our power through the name of Jesus. He has the power and through faith we are to exercise the authority He gives us to fulfill His will and the completion His mission. What is His mission, you may ask. It is to glorify God, the Father, offer the truth of His Kingdom and bare fruit of His right-standing with God as the one sent by the edict of the Father. And we are His body. We are to enforce, carry out and establish the kingdom in the earth today in every life and body we are allowed.

"23 And the scripture was fulfilled which saith, Abraham believed God, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called the Friend of God." James 2:23 KJV

Believing God is right. If Jesus rebuked fever, like in the case of Peter's mother-in-law and it left, we can also, by walking in His steps, speaking in His faith, produce fruit of right-standing with God. And Jesus produced much in the area of healing and deliverance.

"16 And I brought him to thy disciples, and they could not cure him. 17 Then Jesus answered and said, O faithless and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you? how long shall I suffer you? bring him hither to me. 18 And Jesus rebuked the devil; and he departed out of him: and the child was cured from that very hour. 19 Then came the disciples to Jesus apart, and said, Why could not we cast him out? 20 And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you. 21 Howbeit this kind goeth not out but by prayer and fasting." Matt 17:16-20 KJV

He delivered many through his right-standing in God and fellowship with His Father, and denying himself through prayer and putting God's kingdom first, even before the food of the natural body.

My point in all of this is that we have the power through the authority of Jesus' name, that is, His right-standing with the Father to apply the Word of God to our bodies. Let us speak the Word of God in faith believing that because of Jesus, the sickness will go and healing will come. Let us believe that healing will be released to our bodies and wholeness will manifest. Let us take back authority over our bodies and any evil attacking or ravishing our bodies by believing God and having faith in His Word.

Take authority over your body. Speak life to your body and agree with God that it is subject to change. Speak death to the curse of evil trying to invade your body and command these symptoms, these pains, these infirmities to die and the evil to leave the

temple of the Holy Spirit that you are steward over under God.

Make this a regular, daily choice, to speak God's word to your body and believe the authority you have in Christ to see it come to pass. Only believe and act on His word.
