enjoyed each others company and fellowship. It was great! That evening

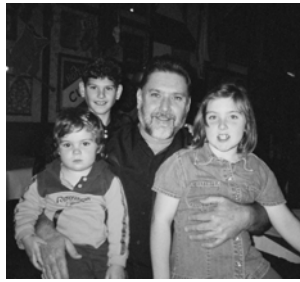

The Journey Toward Healing VII Prayer, Praise and Proclamation for your Healing

I encourage you to follow these steps when you are dealing with God about needs. This includes the need for healing.

I have to be honest. I believe each of these steps is a kind of prayer in our Worship of God. But for the sake of this teaching I am separating them.

First, pray. To pray is to go to God. Share your heart. Acknowledge your need. Ask for help. Then listen. The Lord may convict you of sin, error, deception or bondage. Face and deal with whatever the Lord shows you. Confess any truth of the conviction. Repent of these things. By faith, apply the blood of Jesus to these convictions. Denounce them and take your authority in Christ over them. Forbid them to return. Choose to refuse to submit to them ever again.

Second, Praise God. To praise God is to confess the attributes of God, especially vocally. Thank God of His goodness, praise His name for his faithfulness. Give Him glory for his love to you and His constant provision to meet your needs. Maybe you will need to review or read aloud some Psalms which praise your creator, deliverer and redeemer of your soul. God is worthy of our praise. And this is our reasonable service.

Thirdly, proclaim the promises of God concerning your need. Declare the Word of God which pertains to your request and claim them as yours by faith in the goodness of God and the faithfulness of His Word and the righteousness of your savior, Christ Jesus. Choose to, daily review and proclaim God's answer, His provision for you need. Declare it out loud. Any time you feel fear, doubt or unbelief no matter the source, your own thoughts or feelings or the taunting and accusations of the devil; declare in faith the Word of God. This is your answer to defeat these enemies.

God's word is our response to the enemy of our soul, even if that enemy is our own carnal thinking. These steps are our forward progression toward the success of experiencing the healing God has provided for us. These steps of obedience are our offensive advancement toward success over the warfare of the enemy.

In your journey toward healing, choose to walk out your faith by taking these steps of faith. Arise, in faith and be healed.

I was able to get a line of numbers filled in such a way that allowed me to move on. You could say I was enjoying the challenge.

As time went on I found myself getting a little frustrated. Just when I thought the puzzle was about complete, I realized that I had duplicated some numbers. This threw more than one line off. Now I had the problem of knowing where to start to make corrections without disturbing the lines that I hoped were correct. Suddenly I realized that the whole thing was silly and not worth my time. I threw the puzzle away.

Then the tenacity part of my personality kicked in. I picked the paper out of the wastebasket and started trying to finish the crazy puzzle. Notice that it was the puzzle that was crazy. I felt driven to accomplish the goal. After all, the puzzle was only rated with a moderate level of difficulty. That's when the Lord spoke to my heart.

Just as plain as day He let me know that He had indeed made me a woman of tenacity. My drive and determination was a thing of pleasure to Him. But, I could choose my battles. My drive and determination cannot be the drive behind my actions. In other words, being driven is only a good thing if the resulting action is productive. Finishing that puzzle was not productive. Winning for the sake of winning is not productive.

The incident just reminded me to examine areas of my life where I could be a little less driven and determined. Then I will be more able to be in position to be more driven and full of tenacity in other areas.

Oh, I did throw the puzzle away without completing it. It wasn't worth the level of frustration. Many things which cause frustration are worth the press. I can't throw everything or everyone away. My tenacity can come into play in raising Godly children or helping disciple a new convert.

Every strength has a weakness. Make sure that you are in balance. You may need to set something aside to have time or energy for something else more important.

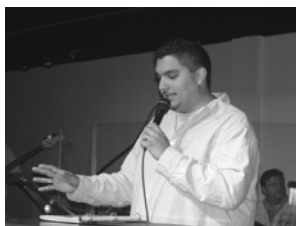
