Key Scripture Reference for 2007 – **Matthew 25:21**



*Well done, good and faithful servants; you were faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the joy of your Lord.
(Matthew 25:21)NKJV*

This passage addresses three qualities of Son Grace Music Ministries that the Lord wants you to give attention to in 2007:

1. **FAITHFULNESS:** (key word here is — OBEDIENCE)
 - a. Faithful to obey the Word of God:
 - Logos (revealed word in the Bible)
 - Rhema (words spoken to you by the Holy Spirit)
 - b. Faithful to respond to the Holy Spirit's leading
 - What you sense
 - What you see
 - c. Faithful to the assignments God gives you
 - Ministry as God intends it to be in each assignment.
 - Minister the anointing in the house
2. **FRUITFULNESS:** (key word here is — INCREASE)
 - a. Increase in spiritual fruit & gifts
 - MORE fruit of the Spirit evident in your ministry.
 - MORE gifts of me Spirit evident in your ministry.
 - b. Increase in the fruit of the harvest
 - MORE in quantity
 - MORE in diversity (watch for opportunities to minister to a variety of people groups in 2007)
 - c. Increase in material fruitfulness so the ministry can expand
 - MORE monthly supporters
 - MORE finances to come into your hands
3. **FOCUS:** (key word here is — CLARITY)
 - a. Sharpen your focus so that hidden things can be revealed.
 - Reveal things that are being birthed by the Holy Spirit.
 - See what God is doing and cooperate with Him.

The Power of Unity of Agreement

Taken as a whole, the Church is weak. The Church is failing. The Church has acted powerless to represent God and His reason for its existence. Thus the Church is missing the mark of the high calling of God. The Church does not know what kind of spirit they commonly minister out of. The Church does not yet know of what Spirit they were birthed from and are to live by.

The Church does not yet understand that only, in agreement with the Holy Spirit, can they succeed in fulfilling their purpose and mission. Only in the Unity of the Holy Spirit will they demonstrate the will of the Father and the power of the Son. There is power in the spirit of unity. There is power in the unity of agreement. That is, agreement with the rule and leading of the Holy Spirit.

I am not talking about conformity or agreement with others to appease or compromise. I am talking about the power of God which is displayed through the agreement of the Church with the will of

the Spirit, who is the living God. I am talking about the only solution the Church has, to succeed. This is the only way we can accomplish God's mission on earth. This is the only way we will live out the life, death and resurrection of Christ, our Lord.

By unity, I mean oneness with God's edict. Which can not take place until we, the Church becomes unanimous in our anonymity. I use this interesting phrase to point out that to be unanimous in Christ (of one mind with Christ); we must sacrifice our individual thoughts of rightness, our opinions, our selective beliefs, traditions and agendas.

The Church has been so busy striving to prove individual or sectarian righteousness or to claim the favor of God toward their particular understanding of truth. They misunderstand what Spirit they are to be of, what Spirit they are to minister out of. They miss out on the power of agreement brought about by the unity in His Spirit. Unity in the Spirit is not agreement with each other. It is agreement with the Holy Spirit in lieu of selfish ambitions, doctrines, sects or individual understanding.

For there the LORD bestows his blessing, even life forevermore." Ps 133:1-3

These verses speak of the anointing. The anointing in the Old Testament pictures the blessings caused by the authority of Godly leaders using their power to serve God through His people, His representation on earth.

The power of unity was demonstrated by the faithful, in submission and anonymity on the day of Pentecost when the believers "were all with one accord in one place" (Acts 2:1). That means they put the will of God above any and all the individual personalities and agendas of those involved. The power of the Church in Acts 2 was seen in the boldness, the liberty and the accomplishment of the Spirit in reaching 3,000 souls for the Kingdom of God.

Agreement means, to be of the same mind, the mind of Christ, the anointed one. Agreement among the members of the Body of Christ must be like those in these next verses. "7 For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one. 8 And there are three that bear witness in earth, the spirit, and the water, and the blood: and these three agree in one. I John 5:7-8 KJV That is, one mind, one purpose, one spirit.

18 "Verily I say unto you, what things soever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven; and

what things soever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

19 Again I say unto you, that if two of you shall agree on earth as touching anything that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father who is in heaven.

20 For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them."

Matt 18:18-21 KJV

To agree is to blend together into one harmonious body of purpose. This kind of agreement is an inward work of unity in the Church produced by the Holy Spirit leading to the fulfillment of God's will. This will demonstrate the presence of Christ, still in the earth, proclaiming and establishing the Kingdom of God.

One of the great sins of the Church is the arrogance of individual selves refusing to put the purpose, the will and the leading of the Holy Spirit, above selfish opinions. So little is accomplished in the Church because we refuse to put agreement with God above our individual personalities and beliefs of what we think is right.

There are three with which we must unite in agreement, if we want to see the power of the Holy Spirit this year. We must submit our pride, for unity with the will of God that His kingdom might be established. We must surrender our understanding and our opinions to the Holy Spirit and choose to agree with each other, like our spouse or our partner in ministry or our friend in Christ that our prayers may be answered. We must put the oneness of the Body of Christ universal about our misunderstandings or disagreements or peculiarities so the world may see Jesus alive and glorified.

It is not about us. It is about God and His will on earth. We must die to pride, submit to God and agree to unite with each other in the Holy Spirit.
