They are founders of Message of Hope Ministries – a ministry of healing and deliverance that God gave them following the death of their oldest son, Macon, Jr.

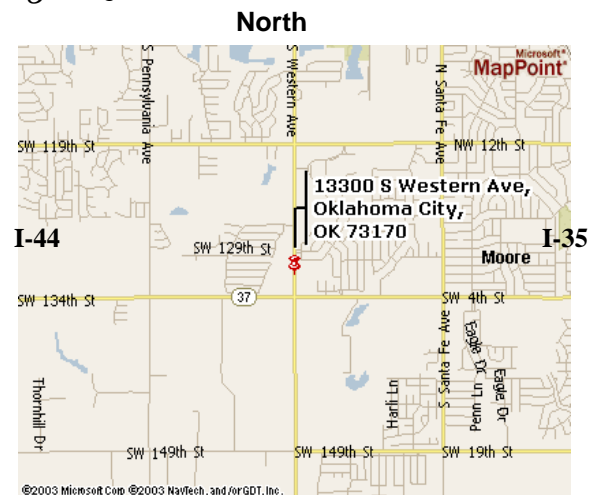

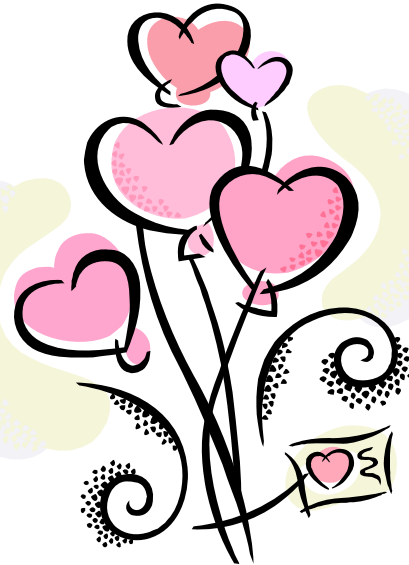

The Power, Through Stewardship of Your Body



There is power in the proper care and use of our bodies. We are blessed or cursed many times by the way we live in our bodies. Do you want more power to glorify God? Do you want more power to be able to carry on your life? Do you desire to be less burdened by the problems and results of physical issues? Well, consider these following thoughts.

I spoke about the power we have in unity last month. The truth is that our unity with God is supreme. It must be first place in our plans, our decisions, and our choice of direction. Now, there are many ways to cooperate in unity with God. One way begins with us, in an intimate way. It begins with our most basic, physical self, our body.

We are stewards. Either good or bad ones, but we are stewards. Since God has chosen to live in and through His redeemed, our bodies become His temple on earth. They become the vessels of honor to glorify Him or to simply reflect our self-centered

misuse of His contained presence. And God takes this responsibility seriously.

16 Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?

17 If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy; for the temple of God is holy, which temple ye are. 1 Cor 3:16-17 KJV

Now, there are many ways to defile His temple. But the one I want to talk about is our health. The truth is we are given this body. We are not responsible for the physical characteristics or the limitations of this body. We are not responsible for what we receive. But we are responsible for what we do with it and how we live in this gift.

We are responsible for the care, oversight and use of it toward the Glory of God and the fulfillment of His Kingdom. Society won't be responsible for your health. Your neighbors won't take responsibility for your health. Even you family can't fulfill that necessity. You have been given the oversight of the garden God has placed you in.

You, alone are primarily responsible for your body and its condition, its health. In the old days, we heard that suicide would damn a person because of the verse above. Well, no matter how you interpret these verses, the fact is, many among the Church are committing passive suicide. They are defiling the temple of God. How do we defile God's temple? Just like man defiled the garden.

15 And the LORD God took the man, and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it. Gen 2:15 KJV

Man was given the responsibility to "dress" the garden. The word dress implies the work of a bond-servant to care for the property of another. Man was given the responsibility to "keep" the garden. To keep it means to preserve its use and purpose, to save it from destruction or perversion or neglect.

This same responsibility applied to the garden God has given us, the garden of our bodies. We have been given the care and the oversight to serve God in and through it. But like the garden many times we let the enemy of God pervert our minds about God's intentions, question our need to attend to his rule and allow the enemy to have his way in the garden of our bodies.

We do this by listening to the voice of the world, like the serpent who questions God and deters us from our primary task. Like the serpent was allowed to destroy the beauty and purpose of the garden. We allow self-centeredness and worldly appetites to spoil our bodies and the glory of God is marred through us who were created in His likeness.

When Adam and Eve gave in to the temptations and irresponsibility the serpent beguiled them with they lost the authority and thus the power to fulfill your calling, their destiny. So, likewise to allow the tempter, the accuser, the deceiver to whisper in our ears through the media, through the sins of other or through our own un-sanctified desires is to give up our authority, our power and our success to serve God by glorifying Him in and through our lives.

Grace is not given to us to condone the self-centered, irresponsible and perverted life style of the world. Grace is given to enable us to take up our ordained authority to fulfill God's glory and show forth the result of loving, caring and obedience servants of God. Grace is given to empower us to take up the truth of the Word of God and apply it first to our lives, our bodies, our health.

There is power in the respectful and loving obedience we live in service to God rather than to our own desires. There power to preserve and protect the purpose of the temple. And that purpose is to glorify God. There is power in the authority we wield over the lying, deceiving and perverted ways the enemy rules over this world system.

Do you want more power? Do you desire to praise God and give Him glory? Do you long for the day that you act out the verse which says, "You are world over comers?" Good, take authority over your body and begin the journey of obtaining health contained in the proper care and forceful protection of what God has given you.

Let your garden be not defiled, by gluttony, abuse, neglect or perversion with the ways of the world. Nor by worshipping or making an idol of the flesh, but rather by service in the King's name.

19 What? Know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?

20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's. 1 Cor 6:19-7:1 KJV
