## Power Through His Image

Recently I was watching the new Christian movie, "Facing the Giants." Information on it can be found at [www.facingthegiants.com](http://www.facingthegiants.com). It can also be rented at many video stores.

It is based on a true story down in the South U.S. and deals with the despair and seeming failure of a young football coach at a Christian School and the absolute turn-around of his life and his team as he gets a hold of the most important thing.

It is a touching, real drama of a life involving living with God in your life, yet with self on the throne. It reminds me like so many things that Christians are more miserable than the lost, if they are not walking in the Life of Christ. They may be saved, but outside God's will.

We sometimes think it should be easier as a Christian because we are not in the terrible bondage of some in the world. But, the truth is that the life of a lukewarm Christian is more disgusting to God than the bondage and darkness of one who is lost. The lost has the opportunity of coming to the light. But the lukewarm Christian can find complacency in their life resting of the salvation of their soul.

During my identification with the main character in this movie, God spoke to me. I was just thinking about all the times I had failed as a leader and how I did not like being a leader. I had not sought the position, nor believed I was naturally gifted in this area. I do not even like being called a leader. It

carries, for me, too much responsibility, more than I can bear.

So, I was re-affirming these thoughts after being reminded of the hardship of leading, especially the hardship of feeling like you have failed, when God spoke to me. Even now, I cannot speak of this without breaking inside. Yet, I cannot explain what I feel, except regret, shame but, the revelation of the truth.

Now, I know these are a strange combination. And I know you are saying, "Get on with it. What did God say to you?" God said, "You are great." In the middle of identifying with the failure of this coach, in the middle of being broken watching his life turn around and as he began to call out the greatness in his team, God, said to me, "You are great."

Before you judge or made a conclusion about this statement, hear me out. I heard God say, "Son, I am THE great and mighty God who created all and I have also created you. I have redeemed you and called you to my side. I am THE great and awesome God, King of the Universe and I have put greatness in you."

All of a sudden I again saw many of my failures and lack in serving God, even in believing God, taking Him as His Word. But, I also saw the truth. Because God is great and God had created me, redeemed me and gave His Spirit, the Holy Spirit to me, I am great. This thought causes me to break inside, to become broken before my Lord.

And yet without the revelation of the truth, without the realization of God's image in me I cannot fulfill God's calling in me, let alone His desire to see His Kingdom come on earth; which will take each of us accepting this image, the image of our creator. God's heart must break when we fail to see His goodness, His greatness, His wisdom in and through His creation.

This is not an ego trip. This revelation is humbling and frightful. Now, I cannot hide behind my failure, the fear of failure or the excuses of my humanity. Partly, the problem has been that we do not exalt God enough and we do not believe Him. We do not take Him at His Word.

The truth is, we have believed the lie, sown by the "accuser of the brethren" rather than the truth. God says,

*"For thou hast possessed my reins: thou hast covered me in my mother's womb. I will praise thee; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made: marvelous are thy works; and that my soul knoweth right well. My substance was not hid from thee, when I was made in secret, and curiously wrought in the lowest parts of the earth. Thine eyes did see my substance, yet being imperfect; and in thy book all my members were*
