Power Through Grace Unto Salvation

I have been concerned for many years by the confusion and contamination I have seen in the practice of the Gospel preaching. Many sources in Christianity seem to be implying that we are saved by grace through our faith in Christ. And that is correct enough. But this salvation seemed to only include the forgiveness of our sins and eternal security. The rest of the blessed package contained in salvation, such as deliverance, healing, provision, guidance and protection, had to be gained through works of righteousness or some successful form of obedient actions lived out.

The problem with this mixed theology is that since, no one is without sin or fully manifested perfect (whole/complete) in practice in this world, we were defeated or at least limited by our lack of perfection (sanctification) to acquire the rest of God's goodness contained in salvation.

The fallacy is based on two things. First, it implies we could walk perfect enough to successfully earn the right to have these gifts of grace. Second, it denies that fact that they are apart of salvation and our inheritance because of Christ, Jesus.

I have believed for many years that all that we have access to through our inheritance by salvation in Christ depended on the same spiritual principles by which we first exercised in conversion. That is, we first believed, by faith that what God has done and has said is true apart from anything we could do nor keep from doing. Second, that we confessed, with our mouths this truth and made it our testimony. Third, we act out our belief by putting our life, possessions and decisions on the line, based on the promises of God.

I believe it is an injustice, even heresy to require self-righteousness in order to acquire any or all the free gifts of God when we know we had no self-righteousness to receive even initial forgiveness. It seems this theology allows the grace of God to work just long enough to get someone saved from hell and converted. It then denies His grace and demands we only get, beyond eternal security, what we deserve through our actions and success in self-righteousness.

The solution is simple, as simple as the Gospel. Our salvation is based on faith in God and the integrity of His Word, which includes all that the living Word did for us and our private/public confession of the same truth based on our continual trust in God. Because, all that we have and all that we need is included in this salvation.

Do you want peace? You will not find it in mere meditation, lack of stress or in even in your most holy effort. But, as a Christian, you can experience peace by hearing what God says, believing it, confessing it and acting out your trust in that truth, Christ is the Prince of Peace. Hallelujah!

Do you need freedom from bondage? You won't gain freedom, let alone remain free apart from hearing what Christ has done, believing it and acting out the goodness of that truth by speaking the same and walking this truth out.

Do you need healing? Again, you won't find lasting healing in drugs, mere exercise or even self-righteous living (as if you could). You will only experience this wholeness in listening to what God says, believing it to be true and then acting out the hope of His glory by speaking what He spoke and living out that.

Does this sound familiar? It should. Because, if you are a Christian, that is, you were saved by the righteous work of Christ's holy blood shed for you, you already began to practice this revelation. You heard that God has done through Christ, Jesus. You chose to believe by faith in His intention and love for

you and in the righteousness of His legal ability to save you. Then you confessed with your mouth the glory of that truth and began to live out your life as a blood bought, adopted, child of God, learning all that means.

These same principles will manifest all the goodness of salvation that God has provided through Jesus' sacrifice and resurrection. Let's stop, let's repent of trying anything else in attempting to gain, acquire or manifest His goodness contained in His promises.

Let's find out what God has done. Let's listen to what God has done. Let's believe what God has done. Let's confess what God was done. And let's celebrate His goodness by living it out. His word contains these promises. Even our faith, comes as a gift to be able to believe and continues to grow as we hear, speak and act out the truth of His promise
