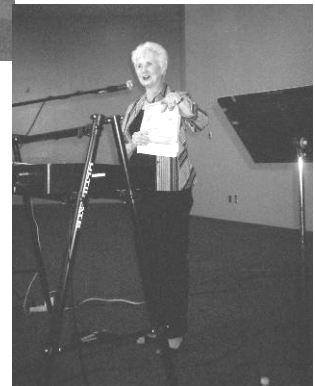

Power In Withholding Judgement

Although this may sometimes even apply to judging behavior, I am talking about the kind of fault finding, condemnation and rejection of a person we are usually guilty of when we make snap judgments.

The problem with judging is that most of the time we are not righteous in our judgment. Most of the time we judge out of our preference, our tradition, our culture, out of our self-righteousness rather than judging out of the Spirit of God.

7:1 Judge not, that ye be not judged.

2 For with what judgment ye judge, ye shall be judged: and with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you again.

3 And why beholdest thou the mote that is in thy brother's eye, but considerest not the beam that is in thine own eye?

4 Or how wilt thou say to thy brother, Let me pull out the mote out of thine eye; and, behold, a beam is in thine own eye?

5 Thou hypocrite, first cast out the beam out of thine own eye; and then shalt thou see clearly to cast out the mote out of thy brother's eye.

Matthew 7:1-5 KJV

Most of the time when we judge another, we withhold forgiveness toward them, but rather focus on their guilt. When we make ourself judge we place ourselves under the law. We make ourselves guilty of the same condemnation we placed on another.

11 Speak not evil one of another, brethren. He that speaketh evil of his brother, and judgeth his brother, speaketh evil of the law, and judgeth the

law: but if thou judge the law, thou art not a doer of the law, but a judge.
James 4:11KJV

Even when we think we have a righteous reason to judge we misunderstand that we do not know all things, let alone the heart of another or the circumstances of their choices.

5 Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord come, who both will bring to light the hidden things of darkness, and will make manifest the counsels of the hearts: and then shall every man have praise of God.
1 Corinthians 4:5 KJV

If we have the responsibility to judge another, may we understand the seriousness of the task and the cost of missing God's righteousness needed to adequately fulfill the task.

John 7:24 says we are to not judge by appearance, but rather out of righteousness. And only God's spirit can judge this way through us. Understand that someone's' sins will find them out. Understand that the righteous God of the universe will judge all things in His time.

There is power (ability to succeed in faithfulness) when we choose not to enter into judgment. There is power in not judging before we know all the facts. And sometimes we will never know all the facts.

So remember, judgment can do you more harm than good. Judgment can condemn you in the process. Remember, your task is to speak the truth in love, walking in forgiveness and apply the blood of Christ to the needful party. That is how you are forgiven.
