We had 2 awesome women's seminars this past month. "Flavor of Favor" and "The Heart of a Worshipper" were the subjects of study and they were both just fantastic. We pray that you will be blessed also, as you see all that God is doing in this divine season, and that you will be so blessed at all that you have an eternal part in, as SGMM supporters, intercessors, and partners. One fresh joy that we experienced this past month was having the privilege of going and helping to birth a new work for the Kingdom of God in Tatum, OK.

We saw God do some awesome work there as we pulled the bus in for a week and worked with the new Pastor who is planting a church, Anointed Acts Ministry. We had 5 night services at the Mary Tatum Municipal Building and 5 morning studies at Christ Chapel in Fox, OK.

We want to thank Pastor Elizabeth Knight for inviting us to be a part of this spiritual birth and thank you to Pastors Dan and Carla Stewart from Christ Chapel, the mother church, for allowing us to use their facilities for the morning studies and parking the bus. We saw individuals, set free from addictions, bodies healed, lives re-dedicated to the Lord and the Spirit of Unity released to work for the glory of our God in that region and community. It was just powerful and we give God all of the Glory!! Thank you partners for your prayers on this appointment as well as all of the areas that God sends us into. Remember, we are an extension of you and everything that God is allowed to do, everywhere He sends us and you help take us, you go with us. It is fruit of your labors and your harvest now and eternally. We love you.

We are getting the bus ready for fall tour. Pray that we can have God's direction on all that needs to be dealt with on some issues with the bus and that most of the concerns will be covered under warranty, and that John will have clarity and wisdom as he and partner John D. look at the things that aren't under warranty. We ask that you pray that they can approach the situation and know just what needs to be done. We so praise God that together they have been able to deal with so many things on the bus and explorer over the past 5 years or so, that have been a real financial blessing and savings for the ministry.

We have a 7 service revival scheduled in Wilson, OK. starting September 2-7, at River of Life

Church, so be praying for a mighty outpouring of God's Spirit upon us during this divine appointment, and then we will head south and northeast on fall tour. We start services in Ohio on September 16th. Thank you for your prayer coverage as we prepare to leave for the field in ministry.

There is Power in Reverence

Recently, after finishing a successful ministry appointment in service for the Lord, I arrived home to begin my usual attack and torment and testing by the enemy. It is kind of like being tried on a newly committed decision or a New Year resolution, except many times more severe.

Over many years of ministry I have always found that I am tested on everything I teach on or preach about, usually the week after I minister. Well, the short version is that I was failing the test of God's goodness and grace unto me after ministering these very subjects at my appointment. If you have ever had struggled in these areas you might understand. If not, you are likely to be tempted to judge me. But please do not judge me before the time. That would not be helpful to you. Hear me out.

When I face these tests and fail them I usually began to feel life is unfair and God is not there for me. I began to find myself blaming God and others and condemn myself for not begin more mature. Finally, seeing myself defeated and not finding any help by my reaction I willfully changed my attitude toward God, by His grace and confronted the lie, the stupidity and the dysfunction of my attitude to the situation and toward God.

Having, as usual my entire focus on my problems I had missed seeing the goodness of God. In the midst of one of my late night discussions with God I was convicted of not being thankful for the good I did have in God and my irreverence toward my Lord through my attitude.

I was surprised at the reality of my attitude's ugliness toward God, realizing that I could not justify it, no matter how I felt. So, with God's grace and love, I repented and ask God to forgive me. I began to thank God for many of the things He is to me and for many of the things He had done on my behalf through His son, Jesus.

This obviously deadly sin is not just apparent in me. Many, in the Body of Christ have lost their reverence of God, either through familiarity or just sinful carnality. And the truth is there is, these days, more than ever greater evil oppression and attacks by the enemy, especially against the leadership of the Church.

But the point is that irreverence toward God is not only sin, it is deadly by cooperating with the enemy in accusing God of being unfair and separating us from experiencing God's goodness and grace. It also denies the greatness of God and our witness of His salvation wrought through Christ, Jesus. But the Word of God reminds us of the truth.

6 For who in the heaven can be compared unto the LORD? Who among the sons of the mighty can be likened unto the LORD?

7 God is greatly to be feared in the assembly of the saints, and to be had in reverence of all them that are about him.

8 O LORD God of hosts, who is a strong LORD like unto thee? or to thy faithfulness round about thee? Ps 89:6-8 KJV

We miss out showing our love for God when we fall prey to the lie of familiarity toward God. We do creation an injustice and help the devil lie to the world about God when we deny the mystery, the greatness and the justice of God.

God is not a man that He could lie. No, in fact, let man be found the liar and God is found true. He can not lie. He can not fail justice. He will not do wrong to us. But the enemy is always at work, even behind the scenes.

And we do fail. We do sin. We do assume to know the truth, but in fact, we have not seen much of any true reality without God's help. And even then, only God knows all things.

18 For ye are not come unto the mount that might be touched, and that burned with fire, nor unto blackness, and darkness, and tempest,

19 And the sound of a trumpet, and the voice of words; which voice they that heard entreated that the word should not be spoken to them any more:

20 (For they could not endure that which was commanded, And if so much as a beast touch the mountain, it shall be stoned, or thrust through with a dart:

21 And so terrible was the sight, that Moses said, I exceedingly fear and quake :)

22 But ye are come unto mount Sion, and unto the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to an innumerable company of angels,

23 To the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to God the Judge of all, and to the spirits of just men made perfect,

24 And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaketh better things than that of Abel.

25 See that ye refuse not him that speaketh. For if they escaped not who refused him that spake on earth, much more shall not we escape, if we turn away from him that speaketh from heaven:

26 Whose voice then shook the earth: but now he hath promised, saying, Yet once more I shake not the earth only, but also heaven.

27 And this word, Yet once more, signifieth the removing of those things that are shaken, as of things that are made, that those things which cannot be shaken may remain.

28 Wherefore we receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved, let us have grace, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear:

29 For our God is a consuming fire. Heb 12:18-29 KJV

Although God has chosen to include us in His plan of salvation of creation and even though we are essential, in His plan, to allow the establishment of His Kingdom on earth, we live in a fallen world. And we can still fall prey to the lies of the evil one and to temptations of my own vanity as humans.

Our reverence toward God, in attitude, actions and speech show our maturity. And it also shows forth the Glory His is due. Our reverence toward God in our life witnesses to the lost. And it sets precedence for our children in faith.

God deserves our reverence, our awesome reaction to His Holiness, His mercy and His grace. His is worthy of our praise and of our service. He alone has earned our love, our appreciation and thanksgiving. He alone never changes and is always just.

Show your reverence toward your God and allow His greatness to be shown in you. You will find power in reverence toward God.
