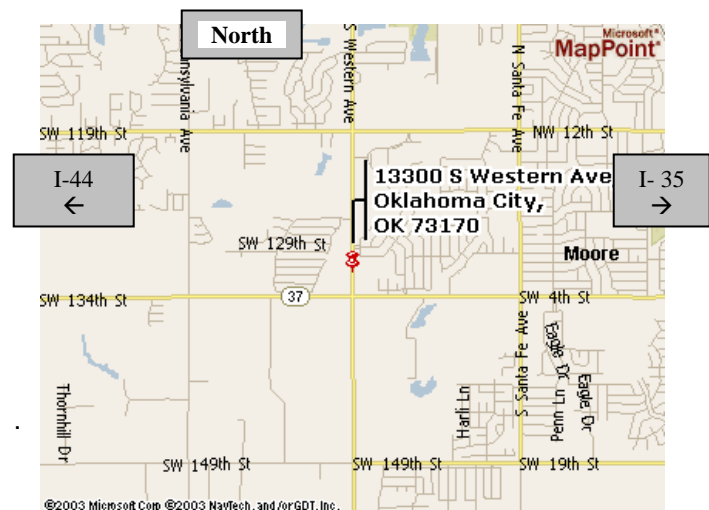

There is Power in The Rub

What rubs you the wrong way?

There is power in that which rubs you the wrong way.

I am not talking about righteous indignation. I am talking about that which irritates you, that which grates you or pricks your flesh. There is power in these kinds of rubs. Because they reveal a weakness, characters defect, an area of un-regenerated life.

Sometimes Christians assume that once we are saved we are perfected. But the Bible says that we are to transform our souls by renewing our minds.

2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God. Rom 12:2 KJV

Now, we are spirit being. We have the faculties of the soul, which are our mind, our will and our emotions. And we function in the earthly plane through our bodies. And when we accept salvation, our spirit is born again and made a new creature in Christ. I believe we are made perfection in the spirit and our eternity is made sure by the grace on God through our decision to accept the sacrifice of Christ, Jesus' life, death and resurrection.

But the soul and even our bodies have not been glorified fully as yet and they must be bought into subjection to the Lordship of Jesus and the effect of His Word. We must pull down the strongholds in our life. We must bring every thought, vain

imagination, every feeling, anything in our life which tries to exalt itself above Christ, into submission to the Lordship of Jesus the Christ.

The rubs in life help show us which is not perfected, that which is not been brought under subjection, that which is in need of the blood of Christ. When we get irritated we need to thank God of the revealing of our weakness and choose to die to that immaturity, that self-centered feeling or thought and reckon ourselves dead to that sin, crucified, with Christ on the cross.

These actions glorify the Lord and help perfect the soul by acknowledging that the soul is not to rule but rather serve the spirit. You see, in fallen humankind, where there spirit is dead unto God, the soul (mind, will and emotions) reigns. This reign can only produce carnality and at best worldly wisdom, affection and ambition.

The only way to deal with carnality is to die to self concerning it and then begins to allow the spirit to rule and guide us closer to God. But there is power in another kind of rub.

When we submit ourselves to God by willfully dieing to the soulish rule and resist the devil, he will flee. And then you will find more freedom to seek God, approach God and have fellowship with Him. The power in this other kind of rub is the fellowship we have with God.

While we pay the price of allowing Him first in our lives by spending times with Him in fellowship, He rubs off on us. He is allowed to deposit more of Himself, His character, His heart into your being, your life.

This rub is actually a kind of anointing through which you are empowered, strengthened, and your soul is even developed, even changed, more able to reflect Christ which is the anointed one. It is His anointing you come away with when you spend time with Him.

27 But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him.

1 John 2:27 KJV

There is power in the rub. Let God use the things that rub you the wrong way to perfect that which concerns you. But also, give God time in fellowship that is needed to receive His anointing, His rub that you might grow up into the perfect image of His son, Jesus.

Father, we humble ourselves at Your throne. Our hearts are bowed before You. You alone are worthy to receive our worship. You are high and lifted up in our eyes. Receive us unto Yourself as we beseech You on behalf of Son Grace Music Ministries and Rev. John and Filese. We continue to put You in remembrance of Your word to us for this year. We are attentive to Your word to see it come to pass in its fullness. Thank You for the manifestation of so much from Your word to us already this year.

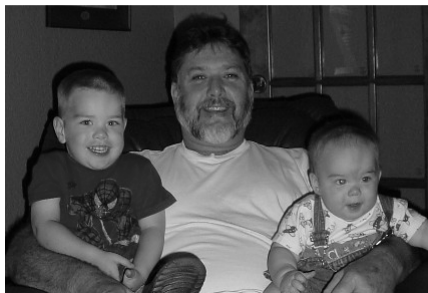
