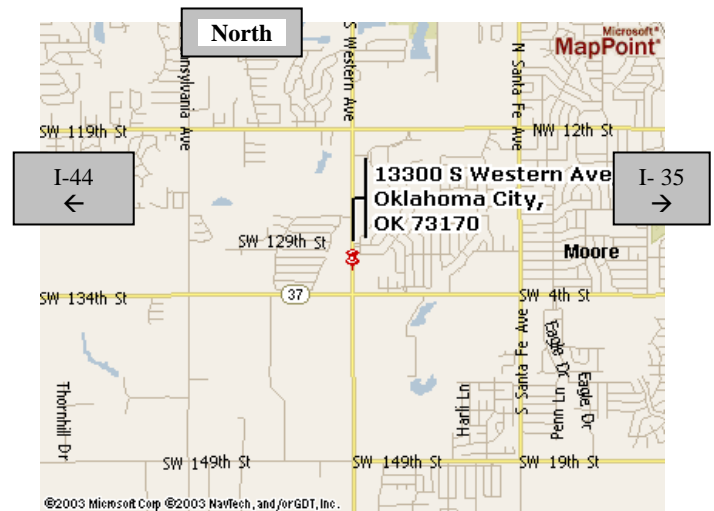

What Does God Say?



There are many voices heard today. You know what I mean. Even if you have learned your lesson and have shut off and out the voices of the world and the enemy. There are still a lot of voices in the world today. There are a lot of voices in the Christian world today. But what

does the Lord say?

If I polled many people, even in the Body of Christ about a subject or about a decision needing to be made, I will receive a variety of answers and many may sound good. Your spouse has an option, your friend has an option, and your pastor has an option. And so do many Christian authors and television ministers. But what does the Lord say?

If you work hard, gathering all the facts that you can and prioritize the list you might find yourself even more confused. If you place the pros and cons on a sheet of paper and add up the possibilities to choose from, it may look like one outweighs the other. But what does the Lord say?

You may decide to go to an expert or search out the wisdom of the Church throughout history and their advice may apply to your situation. But how do you know for sure? How do you know that the answer is the one you need for each situation? But the Lord knows.

In many things the wisdom of the ages through the Church can aid and help direct your life's decision. And the teachings of the Bible certainly open our eyes and illuminate our way.

But many misdirected, well meaning people, have taken a verse out of context or simply relied on a verse separated out of the whole of the Word of truth. Then acting upon what they thought was a magical answer, they found how costly the consequences, their ignorance of the Holy Spirit was. So, what does the Lord say?

I know many will say that the Bible is our only sure foundation of virtue and eternal wisdom and I would agree. But even our Bible, translated in our language and taught from pulpits across the nation must be interpreted and applied to our individual situations. And that takes God, in the form of the Holy Spirit to make it alive and applicable to our current understanding of reality.

That is why I ask the question, but what does the Lord say?

Before anyone judges me or decides I have lost my faith, hear me out. The Bible says in 2 Cor. 2:5-6:

5 Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think any thing as of ourselves; but our sufficiency is of God;

6 Who also hath made us able ministers of the New Testament; not of the letter, but of the spirit: for the letter killeth, but the spirit giveth life. KJV

I have known many so-called well meaning souls who have destroyed their lives and/or caused others to stumble in their faith because they misunderstood the Bible, the Word of God.

You see, they used the letter of the law (the intellectual written words of a translated work of scripture) as they understood them to try to live out their life rather than being led into all truth, which is the spirit of the law by walking with God and allowing the Holy Spirit to make the Word come spiritually alive.

So, what does the Lord say?

Even if one was so enlightened that they could understand the eternal truth spoken of in the written Word, they would need the working of the Holy Spirit to have faith enough to act upon the Word.

2 For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard it.

Heb 4:2 KJV

And the Lord says....

For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one and these three agree. 1 John 5:7, 8b KJV

My point is that we need the Holy Spirit to interpret the Word, for He wrote it. Second, the Word and the Spirit agree. Third, the Spirit gives life to us through the hearing of the Word.

Finally, we need the leading of the Holy Spirit to know how, where and when to apply the truth and wisdom of the Word to our life situations and choices. We need the Holy Spirit to discern what God is saying and what He wills. He is the one who matters. He is the one who knows. It is His kingdom we are apart of.
