Set your House in Order

There is Power in being prepared to Serve God

Many times, most of the time, Christians wait until a crisis occurs to pray. They think that since they are saved, your world is OK and God will automatically do all that

He has promised and distribute all that he has provided for them. But there are a couple of things wrong with that thinking.

First, we forget or do not understand that God has included us in our salvation and in inheriting the benefits of His goodness. All the promises of God have conditions we must met in order to realize them. They are our inheritance, but they are not automatically distributed or realized.

Second, apparently, the evil one has succeeded in convincing many Christians that he does not exist around the people of God or at least is not a threat to their lives. We walk around as if we are in paradise, not the earth where the ruler of this world system is the devil himself.

10 Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might.

11 Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

13 Wherefore take unto you the whole armor of God that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

14 Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness;

15 And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace;

16 Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.

17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:

18 Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints; Eph. 6:10-18 KJV

The Kingdom of God is at hand, but the Word says it is in us. And it is apparent it is only manifested in the world when we submit to the Lord, God and where we apply it or allow it to manifest. Only where people bow their hearts to the King is the Kingdom established and then demonstrated.

We must put our house in order that the Kingdom may rule and reign in our lives. We must apply the Word of God if we are to help establish His will in the world. We must utilize the authority, power and wisdom of God if we are to see the enemy vanquished.

You can not serve the Lord if your own house is out of His order. First, you must face His truth. If you are walking apart or contrary from the truth of his integrity your life is defiled and will draw the enemy in. You must hear and know the truth for it is God's ultimate reality.

Second, you must deal with your unrighteousness. If you are not in right standing with God your life is in disorder. If it is not reflecting the character of God you will meet the enemy rather than the Lord in your private moments. You must believe what God has done and says that it might be counted unto you as righteousness.

Third, you must stabilize your feet by preparing your path in the humility of repentance and preparation to walk in the way of the gospel that is the will, the way and the words of Christ. This is a life style. Not only a change of heart but a way of living out your new heart. This is manifested the most evidently as what you say and how you speak.

Fourthly, take seriously your faith. That is your trust and reliance upon God and the integrity of His word. This is the action of believing God and putting to work the faith you say you have.

Fifthly, you must see yourself identified with Christ. Your identity has changed but you must live out your new identity by reflecting Jesus and the Hope of Glory He has given you in salvation.

Sixthly, go on the offense. Take the Word of God you believe and use it to establish the Kingdom and route the enemy. The battle belongs to the Lord and His Word is the weapon of our warfare. Apply it, wear it, live it and use it to fulfill what God has shown you He wants to do.

Seventh, continue to rely upon God, the Holy Spirit and remain in communication with Him always, letting Him pray through you, for you and for others. But also, remember His words spoken and demonstrated through you will change the order of the lives of others and help them set their houses in order.

Your enemy, like a roaring lion seeks whom he may devour. But we serve the Lion of Judah and we have the victory in Christ, Jesus.

The kingdom will not be established in the lives of others if you do not prepare yourself and put your house in order. Their lives will end without hope if you do not enter the battle against the darkness of this age.

But many can be saved and many will be helped as you prepare yourself for obedience and ready yourself of His service. Glorify His name, route the enemy and lift up the head of another in the name of Jesus.

John's body, Filese's body, and the bus in July, August, and the early part of September. The enemy was working hard to prevent the trip to Ohio. SGMM Partners and Friends,

I first met Rev. John and Filese Hauser approximately seven years ago at a morning Bible study in Hubbard, OH, and I have been attending their meetings in Ohio whenever possible ever since.

I lived in Seattle, WA on back in 2000 (but live in Ohio now), and was in town for only a short time to visit my Mother in approximately October 2000. The anointing on that first teaching that I attended, and on the meeting in general, was so overwhelming that I continued to attend every day that week even though I was away from my Mom every day!!!

I was criticized by relatives for spending the time away from my Mom when I was in Ohio for such a short time, but I did not care that I was criticized because I knew without any doubt that Rev. John and Filese's ministry was very special in God's Kingdom.

On Monday, October 8th this year, I was walking up the driveway of a "church" home to attend my first meeting this year after having not seen Rev. John and Filese for a full year. Rev. John was out in the yard with some others, and asked how I had been doing for the past year. I began telling him what had been going on in my life, specifically about a very bad fall-down accident I had on July 20th, 2007, which severely damaged my left shoulder. I had a large, tennis-ball-sized, lump (ganglion cyst) on the top of my left shoulder, which caused a lot of pain and inconvenience. After three visits to two different doctors, along with Xrays and an MRI of my left shoulder, I was told by the orthopedic specialist that I would undoubtedly need surgery to either drain the lump of the fluid, or (2) remove the capsule altogether (which is a major surgery and involves weeks of rehabilitation), or (3) have a complete shoulder replacement (even more rehab). The doctor said that (1) would be the least invasive, but probably not very effective because the capsule would probably fill up with fluid again.

Needless to say, none of the options were good because I have a full-time job taking care of my almost 97-year-old Mother. I was planning to call the orthopedic surgeon to arrange to have something done to my shoulder on Friday, October 12th. I had given myself till then to pray for guidance in deciding if I was going to have (1) or (2) done.

After talking to Rev. John in the driveway on October 8th, I went into the home and sat down by the door. When Rev. John came in, he came up behind me and put his hands on my shoulder and prayed for the healing of my shoulder injury in the name of Jesus

Christ. I did not ask Rev. John to do this; I was planning to have some surgical procedure. I had prayed myself for healing, but up until that night, my prayer for healing had not worked.

Praise God!!! When I woke up Tuesday morning, the lump had gone down drastically, and was pretty much gone by Thursday of that same week. The following day I telephoned to tell Rev. John about this miracle.

Some people would call this actual physical healing a coincidence, but I KNOW that it was not a coincidence. I KNOW that Rev. John is anointed by God to heal, according to His Word, and that I am a total believer. Put together Isaiah 53:5 and James 1:2-8 (see below), and the result is a miraculous physical healing!!!! This type of miracle has happened to me only once before when a complete stranger prayed over my left knee.

As I stated above, I knew from Day One of my association with Rev. John and Filese that their ministry is very special. Now today, these many years later, I have been blessed with not only a deep insight and understanding of God's Word through their teaching of and all our discussions about God's Word, but an actual physical healing.

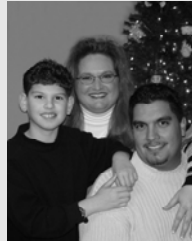
