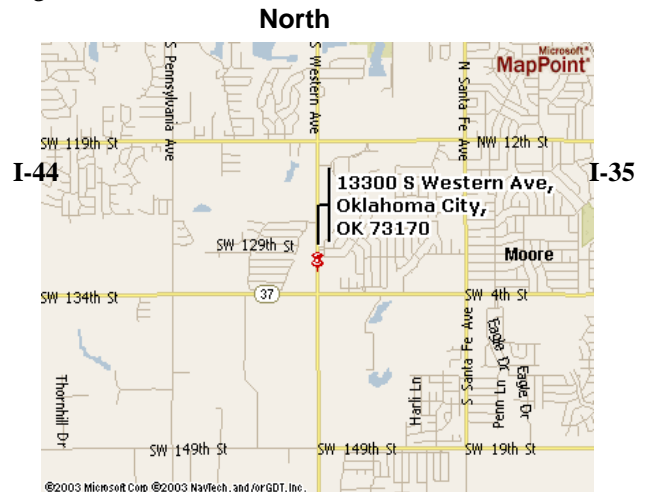

The Sign of Gratitude, that is to say, Being Thankful to God

Being thankful scripturally implies sharing freely of your praise in attitude, word or deed to one to whom you are grateful.

One major lack in my life has been in this area. I cannot explain why but I do not always readily feel grateful for things in my life. And worse, I have even minimized what good is done or that which I have received when I have felt unhappy, unsatisfied, hurt or angry about something in my world. I sound selfish, don't I?

But the Word says, *"16 Be joyful always; 17 pray continually; 18 give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus."*
1 Thes. 5:16-18

Occasionally, when I hit a wall God has to remind me of this deficiency, this sake of gratitude, this seeing the bad, even at the cost of negating the good. So, I repent and chose to be grateful. And I am refreshed for a while. These times are always encouraging and a breath of fresh air in the midst of such negativity, such darkness, such death producing deception.

The Word does say, *"19b Sing and make music in your heart to the Lord, 20 always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ."* Eph. 5:19b-20

At times, I have chosen to become a man of praise, one noted for his continual praise of God. But I have often failed and eventually seem to return to my lifelong pattern. I don't recommend this way of life. It is hard and self defeating.

Instead, the Word says, "16 Be joyful always; 17 pray continually; 18 give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus." 1 Thes. 5:16-18

Even the disciples of Jesus were guilty of not trusting God or believing in Him as He was but rather was full of despair and faithless in relying on what He had said to them. In Mark 16:14-18 after His resurrection, Jesus is said to have rebuked His disciples for unbelief, that is, not being full of faith, being instead negative and hard of heart.

He then gave them the commandment to go and proclaim the Good News (focusing on the answer rather than the problem) to all who would hear, baptizing them who would be saved from their own destruction. And He added that those who believed in Him would manifest or signify their trust and reliance on him by the ability to do the supernatural.

One of these signs was the ability to speak in new tongues. Now, I believe in the gift of the Holy Spirit and the gift of a prayer language, a heavenly language with which we can praise God and intercede for others. I believe in the spiritual gift of a message in tongues that the Body of Christ might be edified when it is interpreted by another gift of the Spirit. But I also believe that a sign of believing in Christ is manifested through a new speech. I believe that we need to make it a point, a choice, and a lifelong habit to speak differently. I mean we need to allow the Holy Spirit to manifest the sign of speaking a new way, a way of gratitude instead of carnal feelings controlled by circumstances and moods and temperaments.

"17 And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him." Col. 3:17

I believe God wants us to be a sign unto the world by our attitude, our speech and our actions through which our gratitude is displayed for His glory. Now, this gratitude comes because we are focused on the gift of God rather than works of the devil.

"6 Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. 7 And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." Phil. 4:6-7

The focus must be on God, His Kingdom and what He has done, what He is doing and what part you play in His service. If you allow your focus to be upon the lack, the imperfections, the offences in your

life or the evil things around about you the temptation will be anything other than gratitude.

"15 Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise—the fruit of lips that confess his name. 16 And do not forget to do good and to share with others, for with such sacrifices God is pleased." Heb. 13:15-16

The biggest test of life for a Christian will always involve our attitude. And gratitude is the attitude of a blessed believer in Christ.
