What Stumbling Blocks?

In this day and age of freedom, even new found freedom under the New Testament Covenant we don't seem to be willing to look at the topic of stumbling blocks but, because of our enemy and because of the world of sin in which we live, stumbling blocks still succeed in causing us great loss and will hinder our faithful obedience to God. This will sabotage the further spread of the gospel and the establishment of the Lord's Kingdom on this earth in the present.

Heb 12:1 Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us. KJV

We are not running a race of competition, but we are on a journey leading somewhere. Where it leads depends on our goal and the path we take. But even if we seeking God's way and are striving to follow His will we will find that stumbling blocks will keep us from obtaining the prize of His high calling. So, I ask the question. What is your stumbling block? What entangles you or weighs you down from fulfilling your purpose along this journey of faith? What trips you up and causes the enemy to succeed where God wants you to be found faithful?

I think we will be more successful if we will start with honesty and identify the things which trip us up along the path. I think we need to be aware of the distractions along the way which deter us and even derail us from God's purpose in our lives. We can also keep from becoming a stumbling block to someone else through our witness rather than burdening others with our baggage and snares.

Rom 14:13 Let us not therefore judge one another any more: but judge this rather, that no man put a stumbling block or an occasion to fall in his brother's way. KJV

So, the other reason we need to identify and remove the snares in our path is to help the journey of another along his calling. We can help prepare the way for others by discovering the pitfalls in this life

and through intercession, justice and faithfulness aid them in their life's journey.

Sometimes we do nothing because the problems seem too large. But we can start some where by naming that entangles us and applying obedience in the Word to the enemy's plan. We can take a step of improving our life's journey and helping others along the way. Discern that which is not from above and get rid of it before it trips you up or destroys another. For every good and perfect gift comes from above. But the thief comes, only to kill, steal and destroy.
