What About Your Time?

It's kind of a buzz word today to ask about nutrition and what is lacking in our diet. And it is important to know what we are eating and what we need to eat. It

is essential to find out what is beneficial and what may be harmful. But it is even more essential to know what is important to God and what He requires for us to be healthy, which is to be blessed. Just as it is required to eat living food in order to be healthy, it is essential to have living food for our spirits to be blessed.

54 And he said also to the people, When ye see a cloud rise out of the west, straightway ye say, There cometh a shower; and so it is.

55 And when ye see the south wind blow, ye say, There will be heat; and it cometh to pass.

56 Ye hypocrites, ye can discern the face of the sky and of the earth; but how is it that ye do not discern this time? Luke 12:54-57 KJV

Many Christians today do not discern the time, or the importance of time. They may be trying hard to manage their time and even trying to be good stewards of their time. But most do not prioritize their time. They do not seem to realize the importance of time to their heavenly Father.

Even those who include God in their management of the day do not seem to understand that God requires time invested in Him for them to be blessed. And He does not value time given Him as an afterthought or only as a last resort, only when there is some left over.

The time we do not invest in fellowship with God is lost. It is not redeemable. The things God wants to do or share with us or deposit in us are lost when we do not take the time He requires of us. When we do not discern the timing of the things of God we miss the opportunity He has planed our growth.

I hear God saying, His plans for us are dwarfed when we refuse to invest the most valuable thing He has given us to manage, our time with Him. You see, God has chosen to include you in the development and completion of our spiritual maturity and destiny. It is not like God is withholding His blessing, but rather we neglect that which God created to bring about wholeness. When we fill our time with empty things or even less important things then fellowship with God we fill ourselves with empty calories and even harmful ingredients.

15 See then that ye walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as wise,

16 Redeeming the time, because the days are evil. 17 Wherefore be ye not unwise, but understanding what the will of the Lord is.

18 And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit;

Eph 5:15-18 KJV

Do not make the mistake and merely try to include God in your day. He deserves to be the center and reason for you day. But remember, the pearl of great price can only be harvested by invested in the time that God requires of us to know them. That does not mean mere knowledge of Him, but to know Him, to experience Him, to hear Him and respond to His presence. This includes soaking in His presence and absorbing His goodness and spiritual life. Thirty minutes in God's presence is more valuable, more revealing, more nourishing than hours in the gym or planning the best dietary meal or even doing service for Him for His glory.

What about your time? What is the most valuable thing you do with that time? How are you investing your time in that which is eternal and also life giving for your life in the present?

Your time is your seed. Use it wisely. Plant it where it will bring forth an abundance of harvest. Sow it in fellowship with Him.
