Commandments of Jesus – Series 1

Many among the church talk about the teachings of Christ. But few mention the Commandments Jesus spoke to the disciples. These were not just sayings. They were not mere principles. They were instructions about the ways of the Kingdom. This first one I am going to share about is basic to entering His Kingdom. Contrary to some popular fads among religious people who think God will accept all unconditionally, there will be a separating of the sheep from the goats. There is a requirement in becoming part of His Kingdom. You must be born from above.

John 3:3

Jesus answered and said to him, Truly, truly, I say to you, Unless a man is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God. 4 Nicodemus said to Him, How can a

man be born when he is old? Can he enter the second time into his mother's womb and be born? 5 Jesus answered, Truly, truly, I say to you, Unless a man is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. 6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. 7 Do not marvel that I said to you, You must be born again.

And He continues in verse 13.

John 3:13

And no one has ascended up to Heaven except He who came down from Heaven, the Son of Man who is in Heaven. 14 But even as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up, 15 so that whosoever believes in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. 16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only-begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. 17 For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but so that the world might be saved through Him. 18 He who believes on Him is not condemned, but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only-begotten Son of God. 19 And this is the condemnation, that the Light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than the Light, because their deeds were evil.

You must be willing to admit the darkness in your life and your need for His light.

You must be ready to die to the spirits of this world's system.

You must believe on Jesus as the only begotten Son of God.

You must submit to His sacrifice for you.

You must identify with the Christ's death on the cross.

You must identify with His righteousness proven through the resurrection.

You must receive a new nature, the nature of God through the gift of the Holy Spirit.

You must accept His righteousness.

You must continue in trust in Him to fulfill in you your adaption as a child of God and as a citizen of His Kingdom.

The Bible does not say you will be saved because God loves all humankind. It says God loved all humankind so much He made a way to judge the wrong, evil, sin and perversion of fallen creation and through His grace, offered forgiveness and righteousness to any who believed and accepted His sacrifice of love.

Many times throughout history the world has received a perversion of the Gospel. In times past, it has been legalism. But now it appears the temptation is to make God in the image of cheap love.

In days ahead the world will try to pressure those of the Church to compromise and even cheapen the Gospel. But be clear, your commandment to make disciples is only affirmed if you represent the truth as the Bible declares.

If you participate in making disciples in Jesus' name, they must come to the place of being born again through of knowledge of the Truth.
