

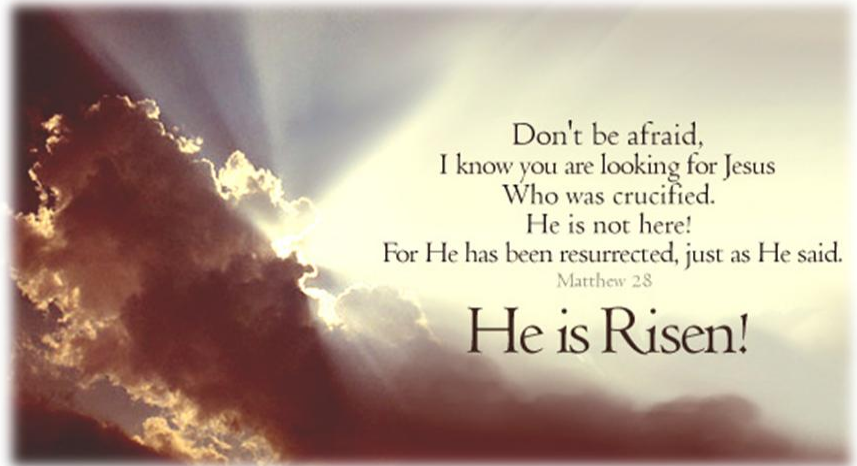


SGMM Partner Update
